

Grading & Grade Classification - Grading Policy

Students will earn a minimum of nine (9) grades each nine-weeks. The nine weeks grade report is a progress report, not a report card. Grades are cumulative (totaled for the eighteen weeks in a semester, not averaged each nine weeks separately) until the end of a semester. The grades on a student's second nine-weeks and fourth nine-weeks progress reports are the semester grades, and these are grades posted to the student's official transcript.

TPSS Grading Scale

Act 428 of the 2024 Legislative Session requires **all public schools** to use a uniform ten-point grading scale. For the **upcoming 2024-2025 school year**, TPSS and Loranger High School will **move from a seven-point grading scale to a ten-point grading scale.**

Grade Classifications

Grade and Advisory classification are determined by the number of units earned by the beginning of the school year. Transitional 9th graders will be classified as a 9th grade student for at least one semester following the Transitional 9th grade year regardless of units earned. The classification is changed at the end of each semester, if requirements are met.

Grade Level	Credits Earned
9th	0 - 5.5
10th	6.0 - 10.5
11th	11.0 - 16.5
12th	17.0 +
