Summer Camp Packing List

Bags should be backpacks or duffle bags that can be carried by your scout.

Reasonably sized foot lockers can also be used

Full Scout Uniform (Troop 373 always travels in full uniform to and from camp)

Personal Gear

Day Pack (Must have)

Water Bottle (Must have)

Personal Mess Kit

Sleeping Bag

Sleeping Pad (No Large blow up mattress's just a single person pad/air mattress)

Pillow

Single sheet for hot nights at camp

6 x 8 tarp and 50 feet of paracord (for tent water proofing)

Flash light or head lamp

Extra Batteries

Rain Gear

Pocket Knife (If they have their Totin' Chip)

Scout Book (With a Cover)

Personal First Aid Kit

Bug Repellant (non-aerosol)

Sunscreen (non-aerosol)

Pencil/Pen and Notepad

Merit badge workbook with prerequisites completed.

Clothes — packing them in Ziplocs will keep them dry

Full Scout Uniform

8 pairs of underwear

8 pairs of socks (full socks if they are wearing boots not ankle socks)

7 Extra Tee Shirts (Preferably Scout Shirts but non-offensive)

6 pairs of shorts

1 pair of pants (scout)

1 sweatshirt or fleece

Close toed shoes or boots

Swimming suit (even if they say they aren't going swimming)

Old shoes or water shoes for water activities

Clothes for sleeping

Laundry bag for dirty cloths. (trash bag)

Toiletries

Tooth Brush/ Tooth Paste

Soap/ Towel

Deodorant

Shower shoes (crocs or slides/flip flops)

Medication - Unless it is an emergency medication like an EpiPen please have it in a Ziploc bag with instructions so we can ensure that your scout takes his proper medications.

Optional Items

Cards/Small game items

Fishing Gear (If there is fishing possible)

Camp Chair

Camera

Any other personal items they want at camp (within reason)

Mobile Phone (NOT recommended for younger scouts. Adult leaders will not be responsible for lost/damaged mobile devices. If you need to reach your scout for an emergency during a trip leader contact information is in Scoutbook)
