- Weekend trip: go to Iguazu Falls near the border of Brazil. Quick flight up. Jungle region of argentina. Quick cross border to Brazil as they have a slightly better view of the falls from their side. Both sides are magic though. It's like niagara falls if there wasn't any buildings / development around. Stunning.

LONESOME GEORGE: Puerto Ayora, isla Santa cruz

>>The Kayak rental is 40\$ the half day (double kayak) - 35 (single Kayak)

Puntudo and Crocker Hill are both similar and in the same place.

There is a Private tourist farm that is called el Chato that you can also visit by yourself. (we will provide all this info once upon arrival)

10 days is the average time guests will spend on Galapagos islands. So it passes well!

Prices of tours will vary from the destination and boat quality. Starting from 160\$ - 250\$ a full day tour.
