Cancer Lion Charity Launch

One year ago, Lars and his family were at the Ronald McDonald house in Christchurch after he was diagnosed with Burkitt Lymphoma cancer. After moving the family to Christchurch, persevering through 6 chemo cycles (and related complications), a stint in Starship hospital in Auckland, recovery and a move back to Queenstown.

Lars has recently launched his child cancer charity <u>The Cancer Lion</u>. He is raising funds to give cancer kids \$25 vouchers upon completion of each chemo cycle so that they have something to look forward to and can buy the toys they want at that point in their cancer journey. Sometimes when they're too sick to do anything, they might rather have a soft cuddle toy than the latest game for instance. Any funds available at the end of each year, will be donated to early-detection and improved cancer screening research.

Why "The Cancer Lion"? Well, simple: the lion is the king of the jungle and each child going through chemo treatment is a king or queen in their own right! Any and all donations are much appreciated and will be well-spent. Lars, your RPS whānau are so proud of your resilience and determination through this difficult journey and we are so happy for you and your amazing family!

Y7/8 = Mon 29 - Weds 31 Aug, Y5-8 Enduro = Mon 19 - Wed 21 Sept


There are other camps that NZSki has available on their own website. If you have chosen to sign your child up
