

ENRG is part of the Nakkertok Racing Program, geared to athletes 18+ who want to improve as racers and benefit from high-level coaching and competition. We have room to add skiers for the 2023/24 Season. We welcome skiers from across Canada and the US.

## NAKKERTOK and OTTAWA-GATINEAU REGION

Nakkertok has snowmaking (allowing 5 months on snow) and high-performance race trails/competitions. Gatineau Park offers some of the best car-free roller skiing in the world, and >170km of trails for running, hiking, or mountain biking. Also, the Ottawa region has >200km of paved paths perfect for roller skiing.



# **UNIVERSITY & COLLEGE INTEGRATION**

Training accommodates academic loads and we combine some workouts with uOttawa and Carleton teams. Athletes will use strength facilities at uOttawa or Carleton. Campuses are 15 and 25 min from Nakkertok. To help manage course load, we recommend creating a plan with your coach and an academic advisor to allow for scheduled training, camps, and racing as well as managing school load within your individualized training plan.

### **TRAINING**

Athletes can choose from year-round, summer, or fall/winter personalized training available at a reasonable cost.

- IST (physio, sports doctor, MPC)
