Quality/Quantity <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 5 – 8 minutes for presentation. Add three minutes for each additional partner. Stay within the time frame. If you have a partner, each student must participate equally and clearly understand his/her unique role. ● Information thoroughly and accurately covers claims, an analysis of the evidence and arguments ● Information presented in a clear, organized way that makes the major points easy to follow 	40	
Visual Aid/Powerpoint <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use of Media Presentation enhances presentation ● Words used little or not at all as part of visual display (never more than 10 – 12 words per slide) ● Visual aid is easy for all students to see 	20	
Oral Communication Skills/Self-Reflection <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students use note cards or bullet points (minimally) to trigger main ideas or hard to remember quotes/statistics ● Maximum use of eye contact ● Group members stay focused on one another during presentation ● Posture and gestures demonstrate confidence and enhance message; presenter(s) do not turn backs on audience ● Facial expressions demonstrate confidence and enhance message (avoid manly mask, blank stare, etc.) ● Students speak at an appropriate rate and volume, varying the pitch of the voice ● Students demonstrate a professional manner and ENTHUSIASM/EXPERTISE FOR TOPIC IS OBVIOUS. ● Students avoid vocal and physical tics ● Watch the video of your presentation and complete this rubric.
