

2. Saferide Summer Shuttle??
 - a. Had a convo with people from orientation office, to do a summer shuttle for the orientation program (LAUNCH)
 - b. Saferide van would do a lil loop from Reser stadium up to MU and over to LINC for people who may need it, that way people (parents, students) can use it if needed and also experience Saferide in some capacity
 - c. Funding for this would be pulled from fund balance, just because it was not budgeted for
 - d. \$1100 to \$1500 dollars expense could potentially go up to \$2000
 - e. Good opportunity to use the MOJO, has more branding, more space for passengers, and potentially two wheelchair spaces

- f. If the use of Saferide for orientation is successful then will have to budget for next years to come
 - g. Perhaps Beaver Bus would be a better option for this in the future, but orientation programs will need to explore that
 - h. Could use it as a pilot year, track interaction with programs, see if there is a significant increase in Saferide service, and such

 - b. Two proposals
 - c. Schetky vans had a conversation with Saferide about the new vehicle or modifications that can be made
 - d. Demo model - 111,890 dollars
 - e. Mini bus - 154, 197 dollars
 - f. Roughly a difference of 42,000 dollars between the two
 - g. Saferide lead team prefers \$154,197 the ability to take more passengers since they do not get that many wheelchair requests
 - h. 10 passenger vans fill up very quickly since people like ask for rides together, extra two seats would make a big difference for wait times
 - i. If they were to just operate an additional vehicle it would be about \$38,000 for a course of an academic year for staff salaries, vehicle gas \$630 per term
 - j. Would come out of equipment reserve if purchased
