

Mobilizing action to restore funding for TB programs Social Media Toolkit

Purpose

To raise awareness about the detrimental impacts of stop-work orders and funding freezes for tuberculosis (TB) projects globally, highlighting the ethical concerns of halting clinical trials and TB services, and calling on the US and global donors to restore funding.

Key messages

- Over 80% of people with and dying of TB are in low- and middle-income countries (<u>WHO TB</u>), meaning those living in LMICs are most impacted by a withdrawal of aid. Stop work orders are an injustice causing severe harm!
- Due to the stop work order, clinical trials led by USAID's research partners have been interrupted and new enrollments halted. Not only is this medically unethical, and puts participants at risk of drug resistance and death, but also undermines global TB control efforts.
- While US funded projects are disrupted, there is a risk of 11 thousand people with TB not completing their treatment each day!
- Airborne bacteria like TB do not know any borders TB anywhere is TB
 everywhere, and TB is indeed everywhere! Without urgent action, we risk an
 increase in TB, drug resistance, and preventable deaths. The US is also not
 immune from disease outbreaks as has been seen in the recent case of a TB
 outbreak in Kansas.
- As the largest bilateral TB donor, USAID has invested over \$4.7 billion to combat TB since 2000 and has contributed to saving more than 79 million lives. Even prior to the abrupt withdrawal of US funding, at the current levels of global investment, it is estimated that 43 million people would develop TB by 2030, resulting in 6.6 million lives lost and a global economic burden of USD \$1 trillion (Stop TB Global Plan) Without US funding, these figures of preventable deaths and costs will substantially increase.



 The US and global donors must restore funding to prevent losing decades of progress.

Calls to action

Support frontline TB organizations and initiatives. Donate to organizations hit by the funding freeze through "Keep the Lights On" via the UN Foundation STOP TB Partnership. 100% of the donations will go to these 114 organizations in 38 countries.

Share your expertise. Sign up to volunteer your skills for communications, data analysis, and advocacy campaigns with the TB Community Coordination Hub.

Become a spokesperson. If you feel comfortable, consider signing up as a spokesperson or source of information for your community or country. We require strong voices to demonstrate the tangible impact of the funding freeze and provide global representation for the TB community. Your identity can remain anonymous, and we will connect you to media representatives for interviews and statements.
