Description:

Using what you know about yourself through *multiple intelligences* and *the big 5*, create a poster of a superhero who best represents your strengths and weaknesses. You may create a superhero, using pen and paper, digital software such as Photoshop or Comic Life, or a combination of both. You may also use existing superheroes to describe yourself, but you will have to spend a little more time writing –see the instructions below.

Instructions:

1. Complete the multiple intelligences and big 5 test packages.
 - a. Evaluate your strengths: what are you really good at?
 - b. Evaluate your weaknesses: what do you not do or not do well?
2. Create a poster featuring a superhero who represents you:
 - a. If you are submitting a drawing, use at least 11x17 paper so your poster is nice and large
 - b. If you are submitting a digital image, please create a poster in .jpg .pdf or .ppt format and submit by email to: **emmanuelle.deaton@ocdsb.ca**
 - c. The poster of your superhero should clearly connect to your strengths and weaknesses using text, diagrams or other appropriate communication

DO ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

3. Create a new superhero whose powers, strengths and weaknesses reflect your own. Some ways your hero should reflect your strengths and weaknesses are their:
 - a. Physical appearance
 - b. Costume/armour/mask/etc.
 - c. Powers/abilities
 - d. Tools/weapons/gadgets/etc.
 - e. Create a back-story for your hero. Batman has the death of his parents, Superman has Krypton... What is the story of your hero's beginning?
 - f. Associates, side-kicks, enemies or anyone else they hang around with.

4. Choose an existing superhero and connect your strengths and weaknesses to them.
 - a. How does your chosen superhero reflect your strengths and weaknesses?
 - b. In what ways is this superhero like you?
 - c. In a 1-2 page essay (12pt, Times New Roman), describe how your superhero matches your strengths and weaknesses, using comparisons between yourself and the hero's story.
5. **For both 3 and 4, include** your scores from your *multiple intelligence* and *big 5* tests on a separate sheet or slide.

Success Criteria:

Thinking: You demonstrate thorough thinking about your strengths and weaknesses through the superhero you choose/create. You understand what your scores and what they really mean.

Application: You demonstrate you have thoroughly applied your intrapersonal knowledge to your character through their design OR in your essay about how they are like you.

Communication: Your poster and writing clearly and effectively communicates your strengths and weaknesses to the reader. Your scores match the sort of hero you create / choose and write about.

Knowledge: You demonstrate your thorough knowledge of *Multiple Intelligences* and the *Big 5* by accurately applying the meanings of your scores to your superhero
