#### Commencement:

Monday, June 1st, 7:00 PM–MSU Breslin Center (No tickets required) Students arrive at 6:00 p.m

Please note that upon entering the Breslin Center at the Gilbert Pavillion, students should take the stairs to the left upon entry. All students will exit the building through the ramp directly to the parking lot. Students will receive their Diploma Case on stage, and will get their actual diplomas after the ceremony. Any student exhibiting improper behavior will have their diploma withheld.

### **Commencement Participation Rules:**

Students must arrive by 6:00 p.m at the Breslin Center in order to participate in the graduation ceremony at 7:00 p.m. Once you enter, you may not leave. Students that exhibit disorderly behavior will be excluded from participation. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted or allowed to participate. If behavior is questioned the high school administration will decide your participation status.

Diploma will be distributed after the ceremony near the exit. All students will exit the ramp near parking lot 63.
