2. School Improvement Plan Goals
 - a. Update for next year.
 - b. Three goals: 2 academic, 1 positive
 - i. By May 2025 CC students will increase proficiency in LA by at least 5% on RISE Assessment.
 - ii. Same with Math
 - iii. 90% of students can describe at least one example of what ROAR behavior looks like.
 - iv. Committee viewed the action plan for next year’s SIP.
 - v. Every grade band is a part of these goals.
 - vi. Explanation for why we have shifted to RISE assessment outcomes.
 1. We have hit our goals in other areas.
 2. We need to focus on areas of need–RISE is a good indicator.
 3. RISE Testing discussion–
