



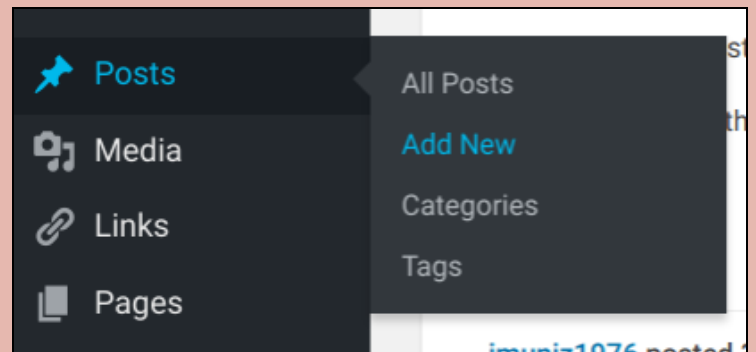
Assignment #3 - The Identity Shadow Box

Log-in to your Edublog ([Click here to go to the Log-in page](#)).

You will be directed to the “dashboard” for your Edublog.

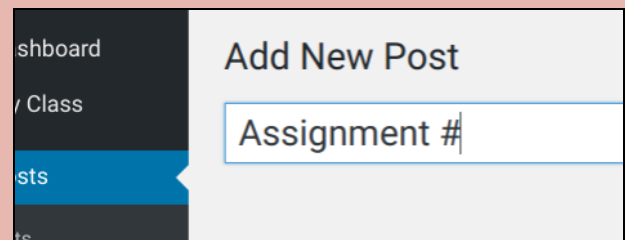
Move your mouse over the word “Posts.”

A menu will appear like the one in the picture. Click “Add New.”



On the Add New Post page type the name of the assignment you are working on.

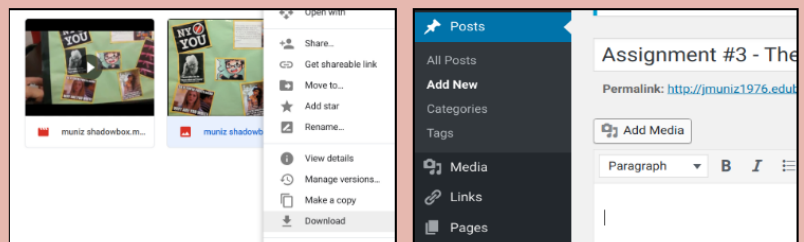
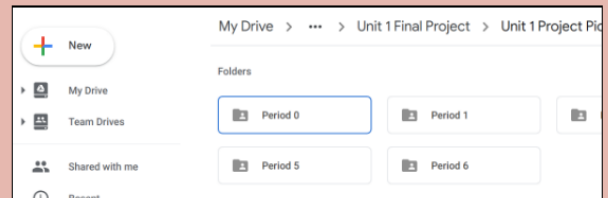
The name of the assignment can be found at the top of this page.

Click “Add Media” and then upload the picture into your blog post. **If you are not clear how to do this please click the link to watch a video.**

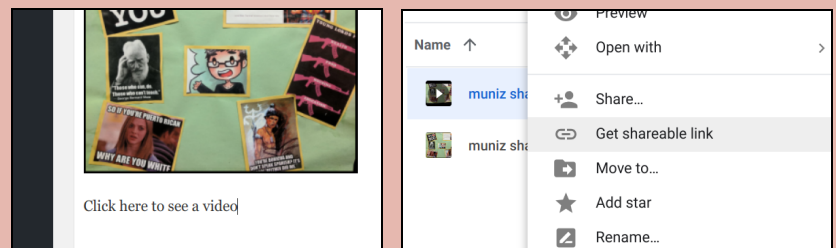


Underneath the picture type:

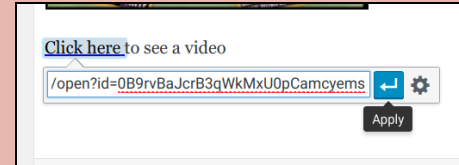
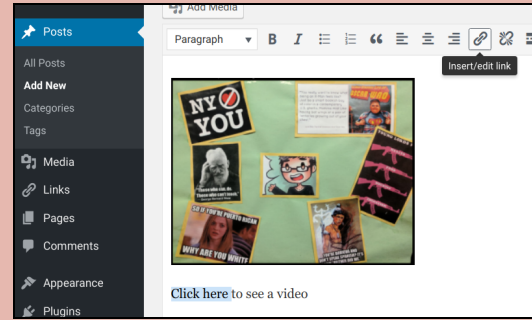

- Copy the “Get Shareable link” by holding down ALT and then clicking on your video



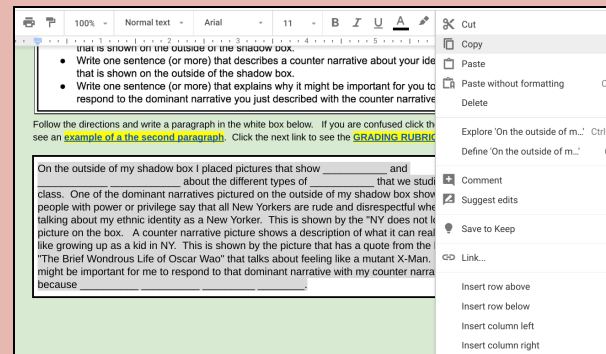
- Go back to the blog post. Highlight “Click here”

Copy each paragraph (in order) that you typed into the white boxes.

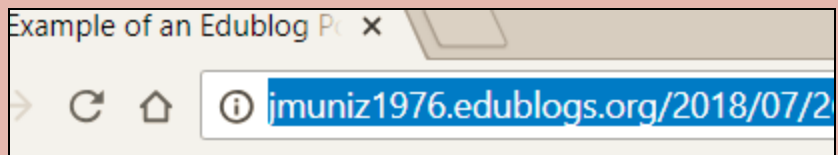
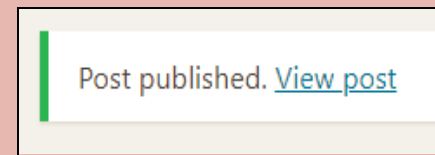
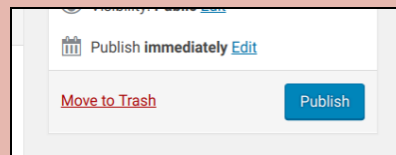
Paste those paragraphs into the body of the blog post. Make sure you click ENTER twice after each paragraph. **If you are not clear how to do this please click the link to watch a video.**
