Student Instructions

5. Work through the problems with the help of your tutor, writing the steps you complete in the table below.
6. Write the answer in the last column. Decide your comfortability level with that type of problem and circle “yes” or “no”.
7. Once you have worked through all of the problems, ask your tutor to review the concepts you answered “No” for.

Questions to help guide you through your work:

- How do I solve this problem?
- What is the first step to finding the answer?
- What comes next in the sequence?
- Why do I need to complete these steps in this specific order?
- Why is this important to this problem?
