

Now Entering... — Privacy Policy

Effective date: June 10, 2026

Now Entering... is a Chrome extension that plays a user-chosen short intro song through the user's microphone when a participant joins their Google Meet call.

WHAT WE COLLECT

Nothing. Now Entering... does not collect, store, transmit, sell, or share any user data of any kind.

WHAT STAYS ON YOUR DEVICE

All of the extension's information lives only on your own computer:

- Your settings (volume, device name, your display name, on/off state) are stored in your browser's local extension storage.
- The song clips you import are copied into your browser's local extension storage from a folder you choose.

None of this ever leaves your device. The extension makes no network requests and has no server.

WHAT THE EXTENSION CAN SEE

To work, the extension runs on meet.google.com pages and reads Google Meet's on-screen "X joined the meeting" notifications to know when to play a song. It does not read, record, store, or transmit meeting audio, video, chat, or any other meeting content. It does not track which meetings you attend.

PERMISSIONS, PLAINLY

- "storage": saves your settings and imported song clips locally.
- Access to meet.google.com: detects join notifications and plays audio in the Meet tab.

CHANGES

If this policy ever changes (for example, if a future version adds an optional online feature), this document will be updated and the extension's store listing will reflect it.
