- You agree to actively participate during pre-season, build season, and competition season and to accept your role on the team as assigned by the head coach and assistant coaches.
- You attend all scheduled meetings and build sessions as well as the pre-season invitational and spring regional competitions.
- You respect all members of the team as well as the adult coaches, mentors, and engineers.
- You agree to **pay the team activity fee of \$400 by January 10th** which purchases the required team uniform, robot materials and team supplies. (If you have any issues with payment or need financial assistance, please visit with Coach Shawn Clark.)
- You agree to pay for additional expenses required for travel, lodging, and meals that are needed.
- Being put on behavioral probation by the administration will prevent continued membership on the team.
- You will check your email, the team website, and ParentSquare for information regarding team business.
