	 Play game What/Who am I? Select three students to stand in front of the board and write a word from todays lesson above their head. The students in front of the board must only ask yes or no questions. (can use voice) The students must reply to the questions by signing 'yes' or 'no' (No Voice) If the student in front of the board thinks they know what they are
