1. Introduction

2. Definitions

- **Personal Data** Any information relating to an identifiable individual (e.g., name, email address, IP address).
- **Usage Data** Data automatically collected about how the Website is accessed and used (e.g., time spent on pages, browser type).
- Cookies Small data files stored on your device to enhance browsing experience.
- **Data Controller** The individual (Andrew Farmer) who determines the purposes and means of processing Personal Data.
- Data Processors (or Service Providers) Third parties who process data on behalf of Andrew Farmer.
- User The individual using my Service.

3. Information Collection and Use

I collect different types of information for various purposes, primarily to improve my Service and provide a better experience for you.

Types of Data Collected

1. Personal Data

I use the information I collect for the following purposes:

- 4. To monitor Website security and prevent fraud.
