Elementary drop off procedures reminder:

Our morning drop off procedures will be the same as previous years. Only buses are to utilize the area within the orange cones. Parents should not drop off students in the area behind the cones. Parents that are dropping off their students (not getting out of the vehicle) should do so between the orange cones and the telephone pole. Parents who are getting out of their vehicles to help students out and/or walking them into the building, need to park between the telephone pole and the gazebo. **All vehicles must pull over to the curb to drop off students.** Students should not be exiting vehicles in the street. Student safety is our top priority and letting students get out of vehicles in the street is a safety concern. If there happens to be a wait to drop off students, please be patient. The wait is typically less than a minute.

Please help elementary staff by putting either your child's name or initials on the tags of their coats, sweatshirts, boots, etc. Every year we have A LOT of clothing items that we don't get returned to students due to not knowing the rightful owner. We display the clothing on a "Lost and Found" table by the main entrance and also post pictures on the school Facebook page. We usually end up taking the majority of the items to the Neighborhood Center. We would prefer to get the items back to their owners.
