Organizational Background

The mission of the Organic Farming Research Foundation (OFRF) is to foster the improvement and widespread adoption of organic farming systems. OFRF envisions a future where organic farming is the leading form of agriculture. Our goal is to broaden access to and involvement in our programs, working toward greater equity in our food and agriculture systems overall. Since its founding in 1990, OFRF has sponsored organic farming research, education, and outreach to support organic and transitioning farmers across North America. This work is complemented by efforts to share our findings with policymakers, agricultural institutions, and federal agencies, in support of broader change and advancement of the organic sector.

Position Overview

The Organic Farming Research Foundation is seeking a **temporary remote intern to work an average of 10-15 hours per week for 10 weeks during the Fall 2025 semester (target start date 9/16/25)**. This opportunity is intended to support students who are interested in exploring career pathways in the organic industry through paid internships.

The Data & Tech Intern will support the Operations and Development departments in building a strong customer relationship management (CRM) system to better support organic and transitioning-to-organic farmers. This role will require tasks in data compilation, entry, and hygiene; researching technology systems and procedures; developing outreach materials related to increasing access to technical and financial assistance for organic and transitioning-to-organic farmers; and general bookkeeping tasks. This internship may be tailored to suit the candidate's background and interests.

Compensation

Starting pay is \$15 per hour for undergraduate interns and \$18 per hour for graduate interns, not to exceed a total of \$2,250 for undergraduates or \$2,700 for graduates per semester. Interns are not eligible for benefits.
