We are pleased to invite you to the sixth annual Happy Camper Llama Show in Estacada, OR on June 19-21, 2026, hosted at Hidden Oaks Llama Ranch (HOLR) by Columbia River Camelid Association (CRCA). **The 2026 show has been selected as an ILR Championship Show!** We are keeping things laid back and leaning in to all the things that make llama shows fun! We are looking forward to camping out and having fun with our llamas! **New for 2026 is Masters level in performance and Composite for halter/fleece high point.**

Show Dates: Saturday, June 20, 2026 - Youth Showmanship; Fleece, & Performance Classes
Sunday, June 21, 2026 – Adult Showmanship & Halter Classes

Arrival: Participants can begin arriving as early as Thursday afternoon 6/18/26 (please arrange with Sherri Tallmon for Thursday arrivals) and can arrive anytime over the weekend. If you plan to arrive while the show is in progress, please avoid driving and/or parking near the show ring to help limit distractions.

Departure: You can depart at any time over the weekend. If you plan to depart while the show is in progress, please park further away from the show ring to help limit distractions. Campers are welcome to stay until Monday. Participants are required to clean up their stalling and camping area before departure. There will be trash cans available and a designated pile for bedding and manure.

RVs and dry camping are encouraged. No hookups are available. There will be porta-potties on site. RVs must be self-contained. You will be parking on grass. Show participants camp free of charge. **If no one in your group is participating in the show, there will be a \$25 weekend camping fee (per campsite).** Those who stay on site will be in a large pasture, the same pasture as the show ring, or in the wooded area near the stage. June is generally sunny and warm in the Pacific Northwest, though there is a chance of rain. There are large shade trees in the pasture. Please plan according to anticipated weather conditions. Pop-up tents and/or shade-curtains are recommended for your stall area or camping area or sitting area near the show ring.

Meals-

Friday Evening Charcuterie & Sangria: Generously donated by Jaime and Keith Bussell. To be held Friday evening at the barn. There will be vegetarian, gluten-free and non-alcoholic options.

Saturday Breakfast: Generously donated by Ed Carraway Jr. Coffee and breakfast burritos to be served Saturday morning at the barn starting at 7AM and will run until the show starts or the food runs out.

Saturday Dinner: Join the pizza party Saturday evening as soon as performance classes finish up! Adults \$12, Youth 12 and under \$6. Please pay either with your entries in advance or by noon on Sat 6/20/26. Pizza dinner tokens will be found in your exhibitor packet upon check-in.

No meals will be provided Sunday, but there is a strong possibility of left-overs; first come, first served.

Stalls: Participants are encouraged to provide their own stalling. There is no charge to bring your own panels, show from your trailer, or stake out experienced animals. Stalling is outdoors in a pasture or in the wooded area near the stage. **There are a limited number of panels for rent at the per panel price of \$12 per panel (\$48 for a set of four), please call/text Trent Getz (360-852-3482) to check availability.** For tear down, rented panels can be stacked on the outer fence line or against a tree. You must remove bedding and manure and place it in the designated area before departure.

Dogs: If you must, participants with RVs/camper trailers can bring dogs. Outside of the RV/trailer, dogs must always be kept on a leash. Please be respectful of other exhibitors and their llamas. Avoid bringing dogs near llamas that are not your own, and do not bring dogs near an active show ring.

Hotels: Participants are encouraged to camp out with us! There is no charge for camping on property for exhibitors (camp sites are \$25 for the weekend if no one in your group is participating in the show). However, there are a few nearby options for those preferring hotels. Please book early as hotels are booking quickly.

ILR-SD Performance, Youth, & Halter Show - This ILR-SD show will be held at Hidden Oaks Llama Ranch on June 19-21, 2026. Performance, Fleece, Youth, & Showmanship on Saturday. Halter on Sunday. The Pack/Trail Performance classes will take place on an authentic obstacle course in the woods. The remaining classes will take place in a show ring in the pasture.

Sanctioning: This will be sanctioned through the ILR-SD and is an ILR Championship Show for 2026. It will be a triple point show for Halter classes and a double point for Fleece-On, Performance, & Youth classes. Fleece-On and Showmanship will begin after the exhibitor meeting Saturday morning. After showmanship, performance classes will begin. Performance classes may be split between the judges after Fleece-On is completed.

Show Fees:

\$10 each for youth showmanship & youth performance classes -or- see youth package price
\$38 youth package - includes three youth performance classes and youth showmanship and ILR fee
\$15 each for adult showmanship & adult performance classes
\$15 each for fleece-on classes
\$20 each for best bred & owned, best production pair, & best trio
\$30 each for halter classes
\$3 each per animal entered in showmanship or performance or fleece
\$6 each per animal entered in halter

Youth Age Divisions: The age division in which the youth will show will be determined by their age on January 1st of that year, however, if a youth reaches the age of 7 any time during the year, they will be eligible to show as of their birth date, and when a senior youth reaches their 20th birthday they are no longer eligible to show in the youth division.

- Sub-Junior Youth Obstacle - Non-ILR youth obstacle class for children under 7 years old for \$5. This class will take place on Saturday after showmanship.

Grooming: There are no wash racks available at HOLR. Please plan to wash your animals at home before the show. There is very limited electricity available in the pasture, so there will be no blower station. While this is not a “no-groom show,” it will be more relaxed about grooming due to the lack of resources available. This includes fleece-on.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded through fifth place in the ILR-SD show. Rosette ribbons for first and second will be awarded in each class and Grand and Reserve Champions for performance and halter. First, second, third, fourth, and fifth place in each class will receive a flat ribbon. We will be awarding animal drapes in Best in Show for the halter & fleece-on. **Premiums will be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions in the ILR Championship!**

Versatility Class Award - Adult and Youth! Generously sponsored by CRCA and Quality Llama Products. There will be two Versatility Awards. One for youth exhibitors and one for adults. The versatility awards will be awarded to the **llama with the highest combined score in performance, halter, and fleece.** To be considered, you must enter the class (Class 79 for Adults, Class 80 for Youth). There is no cost to enter, but the llama must be entered in a performance class and a halter class and a fleece/coat class. For the youth award, the youth exhibitor must be the handler in all classes. *

Composite Class Award: Generously sponsored by Debi Garvin. There will be four Composite Awards for the **llama with the highest combined score in fleece and halter** in each of the four fleece divisions: suri fleece, single coat, double coat, and classic coat. This will not depend on the exhibitor. To be considered you must enter the class (Class 81-84 based on animal entry, not exhibitor). There is no cost to enter, but the llama must be entered in a fleece class and a halter class. *

*Please don't enter the same animal in Versatility and Composite. If your animal is entered in performance and halter and fleece, please choose Versatility. If your animal is entered in halter and fleece, but not performance, please choose Composite.

The “Best Of” Classes - Best Bred & Owned, Best Production Pair, & Best Trio.

Show off the best of your herd! Best bred and owned is where the exhibitor owned the dam of the llama at the time the llama was conceived. Best Production Pair is two llamas from the same dam OR sire. Best Trio is any three llamas from the same farm. All trios will compete in the show ring at the same time. Held after the halter classes, each judge will rank their first through third place in each of the classes.

Silent Auction: As a fundraiser for the show, participants are encouraged to bring items for the silent auction which will run Friday & Saturday, closing Saturday evening with the pizza dinner. It's fun for all to bid and it's a chance to shop while you're at the show. All donations, llama related or not, are greatly appreciated and help supplement the costs of running the show!
