

Conversation questions using the prepositional phrases:

1. **By law** – Can you think of a strange rule or something that should be required **by law**?
2. **By luck** – Have you ever won something **by luck**? What was it?
3. **For certain** – What is one thing in life that you know **for certain**?
4. **For granted** – Have you ever taken something or someone **for granted** and later regretted it? TAKE FOR GRANTED
5. **For the rest of** – If you had to eat only one type of food **for the rest of** your life, what would it be? THE REST OF -> REMAINING PART OF SOMETHING
6. **In a hurry** – Have you ever done something important **in a hurry** and messed it up? What happened?
7. **In exchange for** – Would you ever trade your phone **in exchange for** a week-long vacation? Why or why not?
8. **In abundance** – What is something you think people have **in abundance** but don't appreciate?
9. **In secret** – Have you ever done something **in secret** that later got discovered?
10. **In return** – If you could do someone a big favor, what would you like **in return**?
11. **On behalf of** – Have you ever had to speak or do something **on behalf of** someone else?
12. **On fire** – Have you ever been doing something so well that you felt **on fire**? What was it?
13. **On hand** – What is something you always like to have **on hand**? HANDY LIP BALM
14. **At once** – Have you ever had to do too many things **at once**? How did you handle it?
15. **At war** – If you could end one type of conflict (big or small) where people are **at war**, what would it be?
