How does "open invite work?"

There will be no Application Process for this, meaning anyone is free to submit art, fics, or comics, etc. We will release a sign-up form.

Who can join?

Anyone! Although, as this is a Philippines centric zine, we would prefer if only Filipinos join. We are expecting some Filipino written content (as well as other local dialects), and most of our contributors will also be speaking the language often in the server.

However, if you are not Filipino, *but* have travelled/lived here and would like to contribute, you are also welcome to do so.

If you have any Filipino blood but are not residing in the Philippines, you are also free to join. We only require that you have been to the Philippines at least once so that you can better illustrate or write better for the zine.

How many pieces can I submit?

If you are making the piece exclusively for this zine, you may submit as many as you like. It is a digital zine, there is no page limit!

Can I use a pre-existing work?

Yes, you may. But! We will only accept one, and it must adhere to the theme of SasuSaku travelling in the Philippines.

Is there a word count for writers?

No. You are free to write a haiku as an entry, or even a 5k fic. That's fine, as long as you adhere to the theme.

What is the size of this zine?

Can I get help with beta-reading?

Yes. Your mods will be happy to help!

How many pages are we expecting?

That will depend on how many people will submit their pieces.

Will you be accepting pieces made by people under 18 years old?

Yes. This is a SFW zine. You are welcome to contribute, even if you're below 18.

Can I submit something NSFW?

No.

Can I collaborate with others?

Yes, you can! Please just let us know so that we can place your pieces together when assembling the PDF.

Where will this project be hosted?

We have a discord server. We will email you the link after you submit the google form.

Is traditional art allowed?

Yes, as long as it's scanned properly and fits the zine's proportions.

Where in the Philippines can we draw/write about?

Anywhere. From Batanes all the way to Sarangani anywhere is okay!

Can I include Sarada?

Of course! She is their precious little peanut, and we would love to have SSS family content!

Can I include other Naruto characters?

Yes, you may. As long as the main focus is SasuSaku.

What language can I write in?

English, Filipino, or even a native dialect. This zine is for our kababayan! We welcome all of it. :)

How can I get the finished work?

The details are not yet set in stone, but we will most likely have a form and window dates when you can download the PDF.
