BBHES After School Enrichment Student/Family Conduct Guide

(2025/26 Programs will Start September 8, 2025 and end on May 22, 2026)

After-school enrichment is coordinated by our Parent School Organization (PSO) in partnership with school administrators and staff. Participation in the after-school enrichment programs is optional. Continued participation in the after-school program is contingent on the student's attention to school behavioral guidelines. All students must understand and agree to follow while participating in the after-school program.

- The student must have the ability and willingness to participate fully in group activities
- The student must be able to conduct themselves safely and appropriately in a group setting
- The student must be able to understand and follow program rules
- The student must have the ability to successfully transition from one activity to another and in and out of the program at the start and conclusion of each activity or day
- The student is able to interact with peers and the community in a socially appropriate manner
- The student does not disrupt normal activities making it unreasonably difficult for others to enjoy the after-school program
- The student does not engage in repetitive, aggressive, harmful, or disruptive behavior
- After-school program vendors have the discretion to handle behavior problems as the particular situation arises. In all cases, maintaining the safety and security of all the students in the after-school program is most important. Student participation in the after-school program may be denied and parents/guardians may be asked to pick up their child if the guidelines are not followed.

What after-school programming is not...

- The after-school program is not a childcare service and does not provide custodial care.
- The after-school program is not part of a student's public education.
- The after-school program is not part of a student's individualized education plan (IEP).

Parent Pick-Up

PikmyKid is part of the process the school uses to dismiss students to their after-school program. PikmyKid status should be updated to **"After School>ProgramName."**

After-school program vendors have their own procedures for dismissal and releasing students to their guardians that they will communicate to you directly. Students must be picked up promptly at the end of the after-school program. If you chose to pick-up through the pick-up line, you must pull all the way to the start (past the field house doors). Please obey all traffic signs and speed limits.



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Weather Emergency/School Cancellation

When there is no school, there is no after-school program. In the event of an early school closing or school cancellation due to a weather emergency, all after-school activities will be canceled. All bus students will be sent home on their regular buses.

If the program instructor needs to cancel because of illness or personal emergency they will contact you by email. Students will be sent home via their default dismissal plan.

Parents/Guardians should develop a plan with their children to cover emergencies and ensure that their child(ren) knows what to do and where they are to go in the event of the after-school program being canceled.
