It describes the effects of the climate crisis and what can be done to adapt.

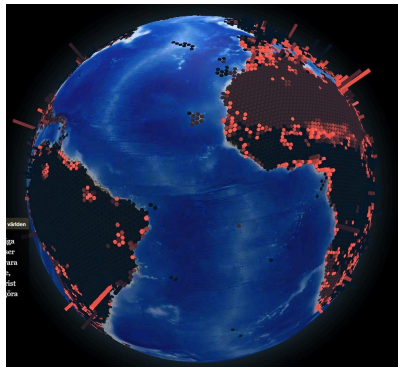
