A district Ready for Learning Committee has been meeting to prepare for the upcoming school year. Arkansas schools have been directed to prepare to reopen in August 2020 and to provide blended learning opportunities due the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. The goal is to be able to pivot quickly from onsite instruction to remote instruction if the need arises.

PERRITT PRIMARY SCHOOL

PreK has moved to Peake Rosenwald for the upcoming school year and will be part of the Dawson ABC program. Many teachers moved to new rooms and second grade moved in from Central Primary School.

CENTRAL PRIMARY SCHOOL

Central Primary School teachers moved to their new location. Second grade moved to Perritt Primary School and third grade moved to Peake Elementary. Specialists moved to their assigned locations.

PEAKE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Peake Elementary School moved to its new location at 1305 Caddo Street, the former Goza Middle School building. It will house grades 3-5 in the upcoming school year.
