Under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, the Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Program funds the strategic deployment of EV charging infrastructure and the establishment of an interconnected network to enhance data collection, access, and reliability.

Maryland has successfully launched Round 1 and 2 of its NEVI Program to deploy public fast charging infrastructure along its 23 EV Alternative Fuel Corridors. Maryland's deployment strategy is outlined in its dynamic NEVI Plan and informed by community and stakeholder outreach, state climate and EV goals, and lessons learned. This session will cover ongoing and upcoming opportunities for the private sector to assist the State of Maryland with delivering NEVI projects.
