Hello,

The Wauwatosa School District passed **two** referenda in 2024, which were voted on in the November election:

1. **A Capital/Facilities Referendum was approved with 58% voting yes in the amount of \$60 million.**

The purpose of this referendum is to address deferred maintenance and facility projects, primarily at the elementary schools (Eisenhower, Madison, Roosevelt, Jefferson, Washington, and Montessori/Fisher), and to ensure all schools meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) facilities standards.

2. **A Non-Recurring Operational Referendum was approved with 57% voting yes in the amount of \$16.1 million per year from the 2025-2026 school year through the 2028-2029 school year.**

The purpose of this referendum is to fund operational expenses, including covering the projected operational shortfall, increasing educator compensation, and purchasing curricular materials.

Both referenda were necessary because state statute does not provide full funding for school district.
