

Collective Teacher Efficacy	The #1 predictor of student outcomes in collective teacher efficacy, according to Hattie.	
	Collective efficacy is best defined as the collective self-perception that teachers in a school make an educational difference to their students over and above the educational impact of their homes and communities (Tschannen-Moran and Barr, 2004, p. 190). So, collective efficacy is a set of beliefs that teachers in a school share, it is not an action. Strong efficacy beliefs lead to actions such as higher expectations, willingness to try new approaches, and putting forth greater effort, which in turn can lead to better results.


