School Renewal Plan**

MATH

1st Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the STAR assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **89% to 99%** by June of 2027.

2nd Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the STAR assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **67% to 77%** by June of 2027.

3rd Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready Math assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **59% to 69%** by June of 2027.

4th Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready Math assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **63% to 73%** by June of 2027.

5th Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready Math assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **39% to 49%** by June of 2027.

Future Topics/Plans Questions/Concerns

READING

1st Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the STAR Reading assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **50% to 60%** by June of 2027.

2nd Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the STAR Reading assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **53% to 63%** by June of 2027.

3rd Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready ELA assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **46% to 56%** by June of 2027.

4th Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready ELA assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **60% to 70%** by June of 2027.

5th Grade scoring at or above the Meets Expectation level on the SC Ready ELA assessment will increase by 2 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth from **49% to 59%** by June of 2027.
