

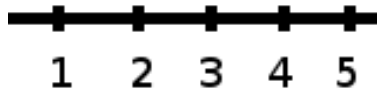
Teacher Evaluation

Before the year comes to an end, I would like to ask for your feedback in a few areas. I appreciate any and all feedback as it will help me to improve next year.

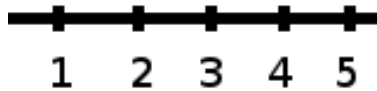

Communication: How did you feel throughout the year about the level of communication? Did you feel informed? Was there a time you wished I would have been in more frequent communication with you?



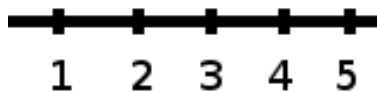
