

The Somerville Garden Club (SGC) proposes SGC share stewardship of the Somerville West Branch Library gardens with the City of Somerville, akin to the partnership SGC has with the city for maintenance of the Central Library garden.

The SGC has a group of 9 volunteers who would

- Help maintain any of the existing non-invasive plants
- Do regular maintenance care such as weeding, pruning, clean up of dead stalks and foliage, and mulching
- Where the existing planting have died, replace with new plants of similar sizes, in accordance with the Somerville Native Planting Ordinance and the Somerville Pollinator Action Plan, in collaboration with the Somerville DPW Grounds point of contact.
- Inform the city of any issues requiring help or coordination, such as delivery of mulch, sending the initial planting plans, or reaching out if there are any issues with irrigation.

If there are any questions or concerns from the City of Somerville, Alyssa Wilk will act as the primary SGC liaison, with Irene Heim as a secondary point of contact.

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
