Final Exam

I hope your day has been going well so far. Although exam days can be a tad stressful, please remember that you are all awesome. Don't panic, stretch your arms and wiggle your fingers a bit, and remember to stop every now and then to take a deep breath and collect your thoughts.

Go to the network drive for this class, "Exam" folder and create a folder titled your "Last name, First name". Save everything to this folder. Open Movie Studio and create a New Project titled "Exam Last Name" and save it to the folder you just created.

• Section 1: (school appropriate)

- Download a one minute or less video from Youtube or use media already downloaded.
- Save three still images from the internet, or use media already downloaded and save to your exam folder.
- Import all downloads into Movie Studio.

• Section 2:

- Place the audio/video file on the Timeline.
- Place a Marker on the left edge of the audio/video Event and label it "Part 1".
- Split the audio/video Event into three separate Events.
- Manually Fade both the audio and video Events furthest to your left.
- Crossfade the remaining Events and insert a dramatically different looking Fade Type.
- Time Stretch one of the video Events.
- Delete one of the audio Events.
- Reverse one of the video Events.

Section 3:

- Insert a new Video Track and label it "Relax and Breathe".
- Place all three still images on the track labeled "Relax and Breathe" to the right of "Part 1".
- Place a Marker on the left edge of the first (still image) Event on the "Relax and Breath" Track labeled "Part 2".
- Expand Track Layers on the "Relax and Breath" Track.
- Create two Transition Insertion Points and insert a Transition in each point.

Section 4:

- Place the audio/video file and one still image on the Timeline to the right of "Part 2".
- Place a Marker on the left edge of the audio/video Event labeled "Part 3".
- Insert a Volume Envelope, create Nodes, use Nodes to adjust volume levels at different points of the audio Event in "Part 3".
- Place the still image in the Overlay position and adjust so that both images appear in the Preview Window at the same time (do not use Track Motion)

• Section 5:

- Place two still images on the Track labeled "Text" to the right of "Part 3".
- Place a Marker on the left edge of the first (still image) Event on the "Text" track labeled "Part 4".
- Key Frame one of the still images using Event Pan/Crop (at least one Pan Key Frame and two Crop Key Frames).
- Key Frame the remaining still image using Video FX (at least three different Key Frames).

- Insert a Text Screen on the Text track.
- Delete the "Sample Text" portion and type in "'Your Name' is a wonderful person."
- Key Frame at least two Font Style/Font Size changes.
- Key Frame at least two Placement changes.
- Key Frame at least two Text Color changes.

• Section 6:

• Render the entire project to the correct format and place in your exam folder.
