Disciplinary Procedures for Junior Students

If your behaviour is not good in class, during social programme activities or in your family, this is what will happen:

- ☐ **First warning:** You will get a warning from the person in charge who will tell your group leader and the Director of Studies.
- ☐ **Second warning:** If your behaviour is still bad, the Director of Studies will speak to you. You may be stopped from doing afternoon activities and/or evening activities.
- ☐ **Third warning:** If your behaviour is still bad, the Director of Studies will speak to you again. You may be stopped from doing afternoon activities and/or evening activities. Also, we will speak to your parents

Examples of bad behaviour for warnings 1-3:

- ❖ **If you do not follow your teacher's or your social organiser's instructions**
- ❖ **If you are rude or you use bad language**
- ❖ **If you are unkind to other students**
- ☐ **Principal's warning:** If your behaviour is very bad, the Principal will speak to you. The Principal will also speak to your parents again. You may have to leave the school and go home.

Examples of very bad behaviour. This behaviour may mean we go to point 4 directly:

- ❖ **Bullying, violence and fighting**
- ❖ **Shop-lifting, drinking alcohol, taking illegal drugs**
