What We are Learning:

Language Arts

- Next week students will be practicing reading fluently and with expression through a reader's theater.
- Later in the week we will be practicing comparing and contrasting our school with another school from around the world.

Math

- In math we will be learning about solving word problems using the bar model (part-part-whole) and solving using strategies learned in class.
 - Strategies include: Make a Ten, Add it Up, and Expanded Form.
- We will also be introducing a new strategy to solve addition and subtraction problems: Number Line.

Science/Social Studies

- Students will be learning the cultural origins of foods in the United States.
- On Wednesday we will start a new unit and shift to Science! We will be learning about sound! We will be exploring vibration, volume, and pitch.
