## Validator Jury

The following jury system has been written up in a way that can be implemented by any delegative voting system. It is currently being implemented by the Validator Commons for a set of proof-of-stake blockchains, and was the subject of a pilot described at

■ Validators Common - Deliberative Jury Pilot .

## Simple Summary

A two-week regular cycle of validator juries to evaluate on-chain proposals across several chains, where jurors are drawn at random from a broad validator set.

#### **Motivation**

Make governance less exhausting. Also: Twitter is not the best place for in-depth, collegial discussion on serious proposals.

### Specification

#### Requirements

- Jurors MUST be given at least 5 days notice from selection to the actual meeting.
- 2. The membership of the jury pool and selected jurors is public.
- The jurors (and jury pool) for a given proposal MUST all validate the chain on which that proposal is being voted on OR the chain must whitelist the juror through some official process.
- 4. The recommendation for a given proposal MUST be published at least 3 days before the end of on-chain voting for that proposal.
- 5. Juries SHOULD be statistically representative AND visibly representative of the larger validator ecosystem. E.g. large vs. small validators, Western vs. Asian validators, etc.
- 6. Jury meetings and witness testimony should be public and recorded, but jury deliberation should be private.
- 7. Unanimous consent of jurors required. In lack of unanimous consent, a write-up of the rationale & discussion is required.
