Selection:

Applications will be considered based on the requirements detailed below. Within these requirements, the committee will balance consideration of applicant differences in:

- 1) Completed application.
- 2) Quality of short answer question responses.
- 3) Participation in sports at AHS.
- 4) Level of athletic achievements.
- 5) Letter of recommendation from a coach

The AABC awards scholarships to students who have demonstrated outstanding athletic characteristics during their tenure at AHS. Each applicant must meet the eligibility requirements as detailed below:

- Participation in athletics for a minimum of 2 years with participation in at least 1 sport at a varsity level during the applicant's junior or senior year.
- Applicants must be a graduating senior from AHS planning to continue their education as a full-time student at an institution of higher learning (university, junior college, technical or trade school) by the start of the Fall semester following graduation.
- Applicants must be a student in good standing at AHS as well as in good standing with the AHS Athletic Department at the time of application.
- The completed application along with an official transcript must be submitted to the Counselor's office by **April 30, 2026**.
- **Incomplete applications will be rejected and not reviewed by the committee.**

The AABC maintains sole responsibility for selecting scholarship recipients. Criteria included in the decision-making process are grade point average, class ranking, scholastic aptitude, academic achievement, sports involvement/achievement. The AABC reserves the right to change or consider other qualifying criteria at any time during the selection process.
