UmmHi's historical perspective of BHO

Hello, I am pordilos who joined Miller as UmmHi. BHO was my first outfit to join. Back then BHO was simple. Get a lot of people together and push a lane. It was fun as a new player. I started planetside at the end of 2015 so I would say I joined BHO in 2016. The leader was and still is Mike33IsBack/BadKarma66, the same guy with different characters. The actual creator of BHO is mash5000. He disappeared just like the avatar. I do remember seeing him on ts3 at times. BHO has existed since Planetside1. When I got the hang of ps2 text chat I got involved in the outfit more by joining the TeamSpeak. There I met people and made relationships. In BHO they have ranks. The more loyal and hardworking you are the higher the ranks. Their main communications go on TeamSpeak, unlike some outfits that use discord.

One day I started squad leading by randomly being promoted to SL in-game. I was nervous knowing nothing about squad leading but Mike encouraged me by saying I was doing a good job. All I did was give waypoints and use voice chat a bit for our destinations but anything is better than silence. I couldn't do much because back then I had a potato CPU. I took a break from the game due to it being unplayable with the charcoal CPU and returned around 2018. I think the past events mentioned happened after my return. I have lost track of time sadly but it isn't that important. My clear memories start with me just playing the game with the BHO buddies and having as much fun as I could. I still had my potato CPU but I managed with 20ish fps in medium fights. I upgraded near 2019-2020. One day I auraxed my first gun, MKV suppressed. It took me years due to the backseat leading style we had and slow CPU. Most of the leading was done by Mike himself when he was online. We would only take over when he was not online or AFK. All that squad leaders did was place waypoints, markers, beacons, etc. Back then beacons could only be placed by squad leaders. Eventually, I started getting the hang of the game. I started leading my own squads and a guy named Asian48 was 2nd in command back then. He would help me get better. He is the strategic type. He would guide me to become a better platoon or squad leader. His ways of giving feedback are a bit toxic I should say, but I liked it because it was honest. If someone gives feedback with an analysis of your mistakes, you know he is a guy to take notes from. Anyways, leaders had rules in BHO. Squad leaders should invite all outfit members every 2 minutes to join the platoon. If you had a higher rank than someone else, you could yoink their platoon with no say on the other end. Look at me, I am the captain now pretty much. These rules still apply today.

In the descriptions, you had to include TATF=KICK. Mike would tell us about his enemies like TATF. At first, I blindly followed because I didn't know. For him to be saying that he knows something right? I wouldn't fully devote myself to Mike's words but I would support him in command chats based on things Mike told me back then. I also used some points of their attitude towards us, which I witnessed myself but I didn't truly know who started it. So technically out of context accusations. I will not say I was on either the good or bad side. I remember having arguments with command myself due to them disrespecting us based on

their experiences that I never knew because I was new. I will not say all but BHO are saints. Sometimes people were really disrespectful in general so the hating was deserved at times. Were the other NC outfits taking it too far or us being baddies? I can't tell hence why this is a story from a perspective. Mike would always tell stories about how this and that guy is very bad just like a grandpa. I am not the type to hate on people for no reason so I kept my distance from all the accusations but also kept them in mind. The truth is usually in between so when first entering a drama zone keep an eye on both sides. Later on, we would see fights between Mike in command chat(again). The baddies or enemies of BHO who in reality were only Mike's enemies. Here is an example of a random fight in command chat I decided to start recording back then. Good old NC command chat (Miller)

So basically people didn't like the BHO zerging because Mike would never split his population and there could be a base that needed just 10 more people to defend to win the alert. Due to Mike's leading that wasn't possible and NC would lose alerts like this. That is what triggered annoyance towards BHO leading. Nothing is lost when you go from 85% ghost cap to 70% ghost cap and save a different base across the map. The video is an example of the average NC Miller command chat with Mike. When anyone would ask for help Mike would never offer help. He would ignore them or kindly decline. When Mike needed help from others he would ask for help from command chat because of priorities. Let's not forget the million markers on the map BHO places to this day to have NC fight there. That's literally the logic. Random NC fight there, please. Many shiny shapes on the map, must be a fight let's goooo. Totally fair to be only on the receiving end with help. Mike calls the defense/attack markers disquilites or something like that. If anyone knows what that means please tell us. Everyone I have asked so far has no idea.

From this point, I would just get along with more and more BHO members.

The highest-ranked players I remember were Asian48(currently in AT7 but frequently takes breaks),tog007(I think he is still in BHO) Himvince(left NC after details came up, went to TR to make his own outfit and then he disappeared), Sgt Blizzard(still leading till today in BHO, Grow(in HRGC now), Mash5000(retired from planetside since a loooong time ago) there were more but I just remember those for now. Not all of the names matter to historic events but it shows that many people including players from other factions have BHO roots to this day.

Things were still "normal". When people used command chat we would ignore them etc like I said. People got a good idea of Mike and NC command started just dying. Everyone knew that talking in command chat was pointless anyway, so why bother in the first place? Back then we didn't have many outfits. All the major outfits that come to mind since back then were NCAV, TATF, FRMD,1RPC,NCIV(Moukass outfit) and LPS. BHO has always been the most populated outfit. I remember Mike telling us about traitors once again and an example was Fallout trinity. Yes, the very same guy who returned to train BHO for the 2nd or 3rd outfit wars. (chapter not out yet) I don't know the guy but according to Mike he moved to TR and he came back with a spy account so ever since then in order to move to a normal teamspeak chat channel you need to speak with your mic to Mike to make sure you are not a "Judas" (BHO traitor). I still was a squad leader. I don't remember the BHO ranks exactly. They were actual military ranks. BHO has this military discipline attitude. Due to people having abandoned him, he makes clear that whatever he says, goes. He deems his outfit his private property which in my opinion is not a wrong thing. It is his outfit, you know. A very

important rule that very few got an exception to, especially Asian48 or 47 for TR chord join VS too damn it. The rule was that if you leave the BHO clan there is no way back. You can leave but think twice, once a traitor always a traitor. Later on, time lapsed, and I was getting more involved in stuff. I started making my own squads and trying to be more tactical. Asian 48 helped me do that. In his opinion, I improved but still am shit till today. I liked his criticism because it was honest. You sucked because you did that dumb thing like what were you thinking? One of his best examples is me pushing an armor squad up against a whole platoon and me ignoring the chances and saying fuck it let's go. He helped me become more strict even though I am not. Imagine how soft I was before. Asian has a huge story so read the Asian chapter below, so I will move on to my side of things as a high-ranked guy in BHO. Around that time he left to make his own outfit ITD(International Tactical Division). Read Asian chapter for details. I will only say that he actually managed to lead the entire NC front by force commanding for BHO TATF and one other outfit to win an alert which he did by a hair.

So we know the biggest enemy of BHO was TATF with Aidenius as their leader. BHO even had TATF=KICK in their platoon descriptions. We were forced to use those descriptions as squad leads. Sometimes, I would remove the TATF=KICK, and when Mike would notice I would pretend that I forgot to add it. Mike would just keep talking with his propaganda every time he saw anything wrong to him like me not having TATF=KICK etc. I felt bad for them later on knowing how they behaved in my platoons. They just wanted to play the game. Sometimes TATF members were more obedient than my "own" BHO platoon members. During the Asian 48 chapter, we had himvince. I don't remember much from him, the Asian chapter will cover more details. Asian had left to take a break from the toxicity he faced from NC. So what's up with Himvince? Himvince was 2nd in command as said above. He left BHO and made his own outfit. The tag was UQ which turned into U later. U queue for victory is the acronym. He decided to become a Judas and made his own outfit. The outfit only survived for like a few months. After that, he moved to TR, made the JKU, and turned it into the K outfit, yes the same one that participated in the first outfit wars. Here is a video of a normal day of NC Miller command chat https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UOkHf3ZB3rk . And this golden video Squad leaders arguing about zerging for 20 minutes on command Please forgive my shitty setup then. I didn't know how to muffle sounds and stuff from other sources like discord or teamspeak.

As I was leading more and more as said above I would notice the behaviors of people in my platoons. Usually, people just wouldn't follow orders. As for me, I was a BHO spy. I would stick to anything related to drama. Ask Asian how obsessed I was with recording drama stuff he will talk for hours. That's how I have the videos of the command chats. Mike liked what I was doing. Recording bad things said about BHO or whatever. Technically a snitch. Mike gave me the black ops rank at some point for my actions and I was the only or one of the only people who had that. Ranks really meant stuff. Next to your name on BHO teamspeak you have the badges which present your rank too. Nowadays it is way easier to get ranked because Asian who was trying to make the ranking meeting requirements hard, left.

I was doing my best to lead squads and platoons. A wonderful time was this www.youtube.com/watch?v=w7huWmike33isbackeMDx0M Watch the first push only. I was

fighting alongside moukass with my platoon. It was insane. I would love to relive that siege. Here is another one that showed how serious Mike was with his leading to this day. https://www.youtube.com/watch?mike33isbackmike33isbackv=3lqM_-5qi_E&t=130s watch from 1:15-2:10 I was there on teamspeak when it happened. Mike was calling out names on teamspeak and I told Mike on teamspeak to let moukass be because he was probably recording for his videos and he didn't care if he was a youtuber. I tried to message moukass outside the video before he got kicked but it didn't work. I liked moukass back then. I don't like his character now with the things he has been involved in (read moukass chapter)but I am not the type to hate something because the creator/artist or whatever is a bad person. The videos were good back then and still are because they are the same. If I find the biggest asshole chef in the world and his food is so good that you can cry I will not call his food shit.

Asian returned from his long break. He joined Himvince, had issues in the end, and left for BHO. Something noteworthy now. Even though he was a Judas and with Mike calling him stuff, Asian making his own outfit, he made it back to BHO after his break for the final time this time. He would max repair, hug him before that and talk shit about TATF. That worked for getting Asian back to BHO. If you want to go back to BHO nowadays, try doing the same but with HAY R G C and KITV. Mike had an apology script and oath in his mind and Asian had to go through that. Asian actually did it. Mike would say a sentence and Asian would repeat it. Yeah, what a chord(Asian's signature quote) kek. To learn what a chord is you need to be one to understand it. It is not as simple as you may think.

Asian was 2nd in command again. As said before he tried his best to improve the clan. He was the one who would test your skills before getting promoted to a squad or platoon leader in BHO. He was the examiner of BHO. Eventually, Mike being selfish preferred some not-so-good decisions like giving ranks easier than before to help people stay in BHO more or whatever he was thinking. He was the outfit lead still so you know, he does what he wants. Asian started having issues with Mike again, not because of what he wanted but because his effort would slowly become more and more fruitless. He stayed nonetheless. A little break from Asian.

Mike hated the crown. Don't look at him now that he loves it. If devs remove outfit resources he will go back to hating it. There were no outfit resources in the past. Due to the crown being the meta middle shitshow base he hated it no matter what. If you made a decision he didn't like he would give the order himself to go elsewhere. That is if you didn't comply with his requests to tell people to go elsewhere. If anyone disagreed with his decision his quote always was do you want to lead then? He did that to me a few times and one time I said yes. He gave the lead and later kept telling me that I should go there, don't do that, etc. Eventually, I gave the lead back. Partially it is the right thing to ask, but not to backseat lead. People had fears and probably still do in BHO. People don't dare to oppose Mike with his ideals. As Mike has said himself, they have a dictatorship. Mike is the boss and people follow him. One time we were discussing this on teamspeak. Mike asked after his speech if anyone had any problems with dictatorship in the BHO clan. Somebody openly said yes. "User from your channel was banned from your server". Not a good thing but I have to admit, I laughed. True freedom, like not kicking TATF members, was only possible with Mike offline. When Mike is offline people including me broke rules like kicking TATF members and not helping people in command chat.

If I remember correctly Asian asked for more freedom in leading or something to join BHO back so he wouldn't feel like wasting his time there. Besides the usual toxic command chat every now and then in alerts

everything was normal. Updates of planetside would arrive for more content and it was "peaceful" depending on how you view things. One day I was leading a BHO platoon and I was disappointed with our faction not being able to fast cap West pass Watchtower with 80% overpop. It was so bad that the enemy (VS)would stop the capture by flipping the C point. I kept calling for logistics but barely anyone cared. Some people were even fighting elsewhere. After at least 10m VS would slowly make the fight even with the pop. The fight was doomed at that point. They even pushed us back. We had the Western warpgate and VS the southern one. When VS pushes us back with even pop I got pissed and I told Shimshi to hold the platoon for a bit while I kick the disobedient BHO members. I was extra disappointed because there were TATF members who would be more obedient than our own BHO guys. I made myself squad lead of Delta

(yes in the past you could assign yourself as squad lead. You still can if you put the squad lead in your fireteam((just the 2 of you)) and move him to another squad.)

and moved all the people away from west pass in Delta. I clicked squad leave platoon and returned. 2m later Mike comes to teamspeak and yells at me for kicking BHO guys like that. Apparently one of these guys was his spy account and it is a bit ironic because that means that he wasn't following orders. I only kicked people with red distance. I told him that I was kicking BHO guys that didn't follow orders after repeatedly telling them to get to west pass. I was 1st lieutenant if I remember well. Mike demoted me and Asian with Shishi would back me up. I don't understand his reasoning since he does the same when people don't follow HIS orders. During the argument, his main point was that BHO members would get offended and leave the outfit due to being kicked from the platoon. A week later I got promoted again.

Summer comes. Mike wanted to go to Denmark. Oh, I forgot to give some info about Mike. So he lives in Thailand but is Danish. Probably retired? We don't know. His trip was supposed to take 1 month but in reality, it kept getting delayed with 0 info. Mike never messaged anyone that he was going to be late. People thought BHO died, everyone knew at that point that Mike left. Asian didn't know about this and was suddenly in charge of keeping the outfit alive. He learned it from me after Mike left. He did his best at first but then, he felt that wasting his time feeling in BHO. Nobody could confirm Mike would return so why keep someone else's clan that its leader might never return. From rummors I heard his VISA expired. Now with Asian being unhappy Jelkor (some other high-ranked player who was in charge of teamspeak), decided to destroy the whole structure of BHO teamspeak. Channels would become gibberish and sign language or weird stuff. Total chaos. Asian tried to fight him but at that point, he reached his limits while trying to ban Jelkor again and again since Jelkor had a lot of privileges there and kept coming back. He probably permabanned an innocent BHO member by accident during the incident or something like that. Asian left again, this time Judas forever like anyone, he was one of the exceptions who became a Judas and came back. That poor BHO guy was Roger something. Meanwhile, I tried to keep it alive myself by leading a bit. I kept it until the 2nd month. During the 3rd I left too. Judas? Not this time. One of the exceptions. I tried to make my air force outfit but didn't work out. I am a shit pilot btw even though I know the controls and maneuvers. Asian is not a liar, even though he left I still hung around with him even as "enemies". I don't end relationships because someone says so. I still talk to him today if I feel like chatting with him and the other dudes that decided to stick with him(not necessarily BHO guys from then). He has his small community. Mike returned now and saw BHO in shambles. He was pissed at both Asian and

Jelkor. Roger guy probably misunderstood Asian and blamed both of them instead of just Jelkor but it isn't like Asian even cared at that point. He moved on. One thing to know about Mike to this day. If he hears something that would benefit him by being a bad thing like hoping someone says a bad thing about him to have an excuse to hate the person. He will rather hear the overdramatized news, than the purely significant issues in reality. Mike to this day thinks that Asian did this on purpose with Jelkor due to Roger's misunderstanding I suppose. Roger was a good guy, I remember him. He was persistent about Asian being the culprit. During the time he was in the fuck it all state maybe he did something I do not know but even if he did something bad after being unable to control Jelkor it isn't like that was planned from the beginning anyway. Obviously he became an eternal Judas afterward. The shitlist Mike had and maybe still does have got updated as always. To make it more clear, it is the top Judases of Miller. I was in my airforce outfit then but it didn't work out and came back to BHO. Anyone who left BHO during Mike's absence had a get out of jail card due to Mike understanding that people will leave if the outfit is dead. I went back to BHO and did my normal platoons. Ignoring kicks unless Mike is online and doing my tactical stuff while he was offline.

Now we move on to the more recent era of BHO drama. After some time, some guys joined the BHO clan. Nowistart and Kitkat. To be precise, Kitkat was already a member but not that old. Nowistart was his friend, they would usually speak with each other and another third guy who also came along. His name was Lucas.

A few days after the arrival of nowistart KitKat for some reason told Mike that he was shooting Mike's vanguard with small arms and apologized. Mike got angry and kept talking about how teamkilling, and griefing are not good for the BHO clan and he exaggerated. Everyone that has met Mike knows that he keeps talking and talking especially if it matters drama. Yes, he did no damage to Mike, nobody knew this because Kitkat told Mike the following days of that action. Mike had no reason to get pissed at Kitkat for something that he did in the past that had no impact. After them almost getting kicked having most likely pissed off Mike I gave them a discord call. I gave them a BHO backstory and told them to be careful with words toward Mike and to just let him say whatever he says to be safe even if it is wrong. I explained how the bad people aren't that bad like Asian who will be mentioned in the next paragraph. In Asian's chapter, it was after Himvince and Asian left BHO. After an hour or so of talking in private I I finished the call and went back to teamspeak.

The following day or days a lot of BHO members were together on teamspeak and someone asked for the BHO history. Mike started telling the story of BHO but knowing Mike it was a bit biased. Not completely but the Judases of BHO was tagged as the bad guys. One of them was Asian. When he was mentioned KitKat said that he wouldn't make assumptions based on a story told to him without hearing the other side of the story first. Mike got pissed again, Kitkat's friend nowistart started defending KitKat. He called Mike "a f beeping monkey". Mike lost it(Got to admit, you had to be there)and after some talking, Mike called an emergency meeting that nowistart Kitkat and Lucas mentioned as their friend should go. Leaders tried to calm Mike and we stopped him but ever since then he always remembered the day. KitKat wrote a calm message about his way of thinking. Kitkat slowly went off Mike's sus radar because he wouldn't say or do things that would anger Mike but on the other hand, nowistart kept "teasing" Mike. I use quotations because he would just disagree with Mike's opinions like attacking that base, moving elsewhere, we were overpoping we should split, etc. Mike hated nowistart more and more. By that time nowistart had already apologized to Mike about

calling him a monkey hence where the monkey sound effect from the matey pack probably came from. Mike despite nowistart's apology, still hated nowistart even though he told him he was ok. The disagreements with leading actions etc didn't help nowistart get off Mike's sus radar and it was too late by that time. The seeds had been sown.

During these times we were many teamspeak troopers and we would have fun leading together, Bobby the second in command (currently in FRMD) would help us or lead himself. We were kind of like a group of friends who stayed away from the one guy, but that one guy was the leader. Mike kept having issues with him for no reason at that point. One day nowistart was leading a platoon and Mike didn't like his leading. Mike makes spy accounts to spy on his BHO members to see how they lead. Mike was most likely spying on him with an alt. Mike was disturbed with nowistart and started giving conditions to stay in the BHO clan. It was first to not talk when Mike was leading. Nowistart complied. He didn't want to get kicked from BHO. His buddies were there. We were at least 10 people in the friend group with bobby included so for anything dumb Mike would do or think, bobby would cover. Not that we did anything bad, it was just Mike being paranoid and losing control. Bobby was technically his psychologist.

From here on some events would happen during the same period of this new drama. I will mention them one by one.

The first was when we first met ValkyrieCodeWolfy. She was a new member and it was during this drama. She would simp for Mike for some reason. I don't know why she did that. It wasn't like she adored Mike. She would just sweet-talk to him to get on his good terms. If you read this wolfy I am sorry but you did say some really cringy stuff back then. Being sad with Mike's attitude against nowistart back then didn't help you be that I should say welcome in BHO then. We all feared Mike's control kicking nowistart if anything went wrong but we also had to listen to the simping and cringe stuff.

The second was outfit wars. We wanted to prepare for the first outfit wars but Mike didn't want us to train. We thought of having everyone on the teamspeak group squad leading separately and if anyone had IRL business someone would just replace them. We even proposed the idea to Mike but he didn't like that. He said that we wouldn't have BHO platoons to recruit more. It was 2 weeks before the outfit wars and all that Mike cares about was promoting BHO instead of training for outfit wars.

The third was Redrory. RedRory was an old friend of Mike. He had his small outfit but because he was Mike's friend his outfit wouldn't be hated by Mike. In fact, he never mentioned the alliance. It was a first for me. RedRory wanted to merge his clan with BHO. There was a detail that was forgotten though. Bobby was second in command. Bobby had a slight idea a month before the announcement but it was just an idea. Nothing was confirmed. Now RedRory comes in BHO and meets everyone. He could help with outfit wars but our problem was Mike's attitude towards nowistart. Don't forget, the nowistart drama happens during all these events in order. Redrory was immediately promoted to second in command and bobby was in third. Bobby was very sad. He was a good PL. One time on Hossin he suggested the best strategies to win a low pop hossin alert. The three lanes one. Bobby would make the right calls and Mike would disagree and do his own thing. Sometimes I even agreed with Mike but Bobby was still right in the end. Bobby made around 5-7 calls to win the alert and Mike disagreed with all of them out of fear and experience. In the end, we lost

the alert because we didn't follow Bobby's ideas. For the first time in my eyes when we lost the alert, Mike admitted being wrong and said that he should have listened to Bobby. Now that guy within one day without his knowledge became 3rd in command. It wasn't the position that bothered him the most. He said it himself he didn't mind it that much. What bothered him the most was the fact that nobody told him anything.

He learned the news because Mike was telling the merging plan to KitKat and KitKat asked Bobby what that was about. Bobby was like What? And we all got caught up with the news.

Now we move back to nowistart drama. As said before nowistart didn't have the right to speak when Mike was present. That was because one-day nowistart suggested splitting the platoon. We were zerging with 80+%. That was the breaking point. We could easily split and capture 2 bases at the same time. Mike got angry and argued. He asked if he wanted to lead but nowistart declined. He just made a suggestion and got yelled at. I and the rest would calm Mike down over and over and Mike would give a new condition to nowistart to stay in the BHO clan. During Mike's lectures, Mike would remind everyone that there is no democracy in BHO. Only Mike's dictatorship exists so whatever he says, goes. He asksed if anyone had a problem with that. Somebody actually did and spoke up. Literally 5 seconds later " User in your channel was banned from the server". I think the guy's name was Satyrikon(NC). I did send a friend request recently but it hasn't been accepted yet. Mike asks afterwards, "anyone else?" The teamspeak was more silent than the void. Gotta admit it was kind of funny seeing someone getting kicked with no second thoughts after the first objection. Nowistart always complied with the new rules. He never complained that this wasn't fair or anything. Straight up ok and agreed. Mike was never satisfied with the condition. He kept pilling them up. RedRory was suddenly caught in this drama mess and Mike kept trying to find some alibi to excuse himself for kicking nowistart. He called a secret meeting around 3 am with RedRory and Bobby. RedRory was just new and he had to deal with drama immediately. He just went with "follow your heart". He was the boss he did what he wanted. Bobby was in a 1v3. I feel bad because I was online but playing Warframe or some other game, maybe Osu. I didn't know about the meeting. I could help Bobby. Mike gave an order to Bobby to kick nowistart in the next morning. Bobby said ok and here comes the next day. Less than a week earlier from that, I called Asian because I am a drama whore as he calls me and I thought he would be interested in the drama which he never one as I realize now. Sorry Asian for dragging you into this after having moved on from planetside just to return because of a border hopping mexican UmmH1. We slowly moved to Asian's discord to have the actual meetings to talk about Mike and nowistart. Back to present now. The morning came. Bobby logged on, everyone logged on. Bobby was sad waiting to reveal the news. The boys and the one girl we had logged in and had a debate about what to do. We decided to all leave BHO if Mike went as far as kicking nowistart. Mike logged in. He saw that nowistart wasn't kicked. We pretended that nothing was planned for that day. Mike a few hours later around 11 am wants to do a private meeting with nowistart about the last condition to stay in BHO clan. It ended up with nowistart getting kicked anyway and us leaving after Mike explaining the situation and Bobby telling everyone to leave if they were unhappy with what happened to nowistart.

After that we all left and let Mike on his own with whoever actually stayed behind because they didn't want any drama association. We had recommendations to go to TR FU and from then we seperated. Some stayed on NC and joined other outfits like Bobby in FRMD, others

stayed in Bho others probably quit the game and so on. Most of us were on FU though. And from that day me not being on BHO since then, story continues with 1ST OW followed by HRGC. The next fleet that left BHO. It has become a yearly event at this point. Story continues from HRGC chapter till today. Check outfit wars 1 chapter which is literally 2 weeks after the end of the BHO chapter.

The end from UmmHi's perspective.

Asian's chapter (the most hated person in NC outfits) (Had an interview with Asian expect this chapter to be rewritten from the top)

This chapter goes alongside the BHO chapter for the most part. It all started when a chord decided to play planetside 2 for his first time. He chose the amiller server. His first outfit was TATF. He got engaged with the community and got kicked within a week. So how did he get kicked within 1 week? From the BHO chapter you know that BHO and TATF hated each other. As I also mentioned, Mike likes to ask for help in NC command chat but never offers help when someone requests it. TAabout that. Afterwards he asked TATF what that was about. They

explained to him the situation but Asian deemed it bullshit(the pointless bs NOT the "that is wrong" bs). Next time it happened Mike asked for help once again in command chat and the same thing happened. This time Asian defended Mike in command chat. TATF didn't like it. Meanwhile some moments later Asian was DMing Mike to ask what this whole drama is about. He likes hearing both sides of the story. He hates bias. He likes raw facts. As he was asking Mike he got a message from TATF accusing him of conspiring against TATF and was told that he was being removed from the outfit.

Asian joined BHO. He saw the environment. As a strategist he likes leading in his own way. He met the people there, he became known with his tactical platoons. From BHO chapter, Mike gives guidance on what to do. Invite all BHO members in your BHO platoons every 2m(because 2m is the cooldown of the spam button). Now Asian has become a leader. People liked his platoons, they had fun. Some people even told him that they only stayed there because of him. It was great for him. Later it became obnoxious. Mike kept reminding him the BHO leading. His leading methods have to represent BHO, invite spam, kick TATF etc and Asian didn't like having random reminders on top of his head while leading his own platoons. He wanted to represent Asian platoons, not BHO platoons. He didn't want to do tasks in his platoons every few minutes while leading a platoon. It was tough on him. Asian tried to come.clear with Mike, when something bothers him he wants to come straight. He isn't the patient type. Asian left BHO a bit later. As said before some people stayed because of Asian so some of them left. Mike took it him as a saboteur since his leave had impact on other BHO members too. Asian is now a Judas. At that point he quit because TATF and BHO were the big guys. He didn't like being hated by everyone and moved on. A year or later so he came back. During that time, a guy named Himvince was 2nd in command. Asian joined a BHO platoon and Himvince tried to bring him to BHO. Himvince didn't know Asian's past. Asian told him that he left BHO in the past and got in BHO anyway again. This time Mike didn't like it much but he would let him rejoin in one condition. He had to say an apology Mike prepared on the spot. Mike would say a sentence and Asian had to repeat. Surprisingly Asian devalued his DIGnity (see what I did?) and complied. I don't remember

exactly how it went but it was something like this" I swear I will not betray BHO again, I will stay loyal to BHO forever" and things like that. It took around 3 minutes to finish his apology. Afterwards he was welcomed back. After giving his oath, Mike relaxed. Asian was co-leading with Himvince. Once agin it started nice but later it went bad once again. Similar to first one. Himvince started acting superior and was trying to control how Asian behaved in his platoons. Asian's leading wasn't representing BHO and Himvince slowly because more authoritarian i. Asian's leading. He slowly became conflicted with Himvince and went to Mike later on to tell him that he told Mike that he considered leaving and Mike told him that he would talk to Himvince about it. At that point he thought he was fucked. He went to his loyal members and asked them what they would do if he left BHO. Some people told him they would go with him. He wasn't the only one having issues with BHO. Asian didn't want to leave and told his friend Algraph(a BHO veteran) to talk to Mike about him. His friend tried to explain the chain effects of Asian leaving. Mike asked Asian the names of people who would leave with him but he refused to reveal the names. Mike let him be for now. Time past and Asian became Judas x2. Some people who said that they would leave with him double crossed him. Then it was Himvince and Mike. Some time passed and Himvince realized that he also didn't like it and left. Similar reasons to Asian's. Himvince made his own outfit. At that point the life cycle of BHO members was noticed. Anyone who joins BHO eventually leaves. Mike not only had to deal with TATF even though by that time drama kinda died but he also had to deal with UQ(You queue for victory). Asian wa son a small break then. When he returned he saw UQ lead by himvince and actually joined him. As expected once again he didn't last more than 2 weeks. Asian went back to BHO but how you may ask? He was a x2 Judas. Mike didn't hate Asian that bad so Asian would max repair him for 5 hours while talking shit about TATF. That was enough to convince Mike to rejoin BHO. From this point forward we are slowly coming in contact with the BHO chapter. Leading was the same for Asian. At this point we all knew Mike so we just tried not to piss him off while doing our thing. Asian lasted for a pretty long time. Some summer Mike announced that he would go on vacation for a month. Mike didn't tell Asian but eventually Asian learned the news from other BHO people. Asian was carrying the outfit. He was by himself. The month

lapsed but Mike was still not here. During the 2nd month or so Jelkor, a BHO veteran, decided to destroy the teamspeak server. Asian tried to fight him but it was futile, Mike had given Jelkor admin access. Asian got sick of carrying the outfit and fighting a pointless battle to keep teamspeak alive by himself.werAsian with literally no info about Mike's existence and left again(the last time) Asian left but Mike still didn't return. He was so out of reach that we couldn't even tell if he was alive or even coming back to the game. Kind of like the father going for milk. More people left BHO

THE START OF A NEW AGE

Hello and welcome to the story of the creation of the second biggest and most successful Zergfit on Miller:

Well, where do we start. My history and how HRGC became a Outfit. Im ThunderstormAT, the original creator of HRGC. I used to be a cultist of the one and only Toxicity King himself, Mike33.It's rather simple. I came from ps4, an outfit called Pa1n, which was on the ceres server and was one of the most elite outfits at the time.

We weren't many, but the ones we had were all highly skilled in different aspects of the game. I was the best tanker, we had a guy called Henry who was the best Lib pilotand so on.

Then, in 2018, my journey began on pc. it took me a while until I started playing planetside again, but i believe during 2019 my history begins:

Back in the day, when the one and only scendikwarrior was still the second in command on bho, i got recruited by him. I enjoyed the leading style of szendic, and did not see an issue with joining bho. but god damn, was i ever in the wrong.

The day i joined the teamspeak server, i had a rather welcome warning by a few of the high ranking bho members, but i was already seeing issues the day mike33 arrived on a sunday. I didn't think much of it, even agreed with mike on multiple things said, like ncav hating on him, taft being an issue to him, and so on.

For me, there was never much thought about it, i didn't like it,but as my friends and comrades were inside bho, i couldn't open my mouth due to the fact that talking against mike meant that you could get banned, kicked or whatever. The point where i started to think for myself was the day where we got this message:

(Tonight SzendvicsWarrior decided to leave us and the BHO behind. He chose to go his own way, trying to go around the chain of command. I tried reasoning with him about it but it didn't help. SzendvicsWarrior started calling me names, names I do not wish to repeat. I might sound aggressive to some but that's just the way I talk. I do not mean to sound or be mean to people that do not deserve it. We have a chain of command here in the BHO that we need to keep intact if we want to be the best. We are all here to have fun and I encourage anyone interested to force command i dont force anyone to do it. All I ask in return is that the armory is restored to the best of your abilities after the command ends. if you use orbies, craft new ones. Try and earn blues for the next force commander so that he can craft orbies and use orbies. you get the point. We are sorry SzendvicsWarrior left us on bad terms and I wish it could've been diffrent, best of luck to him in the future. ALL HAIL THE BONEHEADED OVERLORDS //Mike)

That was the day where I decided to do everything I could to make a new outfit that would be able to give players a better experience at zerging, not just caring about resources, having drama, and stuff like that. I wanted fun, basic training, and improvement to be the focus inside of HRGC.

So, i went into a last talk with mike33 accompanied by Suqa, Phatenuff and Brummbude, and tried to talk some sense into mike33 and see if i could better bho. which didn't go so well.

I want you to understand that back then, it meant for me to say goodbye to people I learned to trust, like, and respect over my 8-10 month stay inside bho, so of course I wasn't in the best mood knowing I'd be kicked anyway after that talk. I believe at a certain point you can hear Mike scream, and that was the point of no return for me and I knew my stay in Bho was over.

In preparation for creating this new outfit, I actually talked to a few of the members I trusted and who had shared concerns with me, trying to get a solid starting base to create a new outfit with a bit of a command structure already established. But well, it was less than expected, as a decent amount of people telling me they would join took longer, or just straight up lied to me.

A little pause by UmmHi. At some point I started making BHO spy accounts and when I started I was caught in this mess you are reading. I had 2 more weeks in my conscription and when I finished I helped Thunderstorm 2 weeks later or so after the creation of HRGC with squad leading. NC was in desperate need of new booming outfits and me being a drama whore I wanted to help Thunderstorm succeed in his retaliation due to many outfits having tried and failed in the past.

End of pause

Funny enough, I thought I was on good terms with Mike leaving, and thought maybe I could be in an outfit that wouldn't be a straight up problem for mike, but damn was i wrong.

I received messages from multiple friends inside bho basically right after leaving, telling me he already portrayed me as the new Judas, the new hater, the new menace to NC trying to ruin him.

It was never my intention to go to war with Mike, but he didnt leave me much choice. After hearing all the allegations against me, I warned him three times to just leave me be, as I didn't want to deal with drama, but it just continued. As most of you know by now, there isn't really any way to talk with Mike on an equal basis. So I dropped all my evidence on the abuse, hate, and straight up bullshit mike was telling his members on ts. I also posted the linked video above, as it was said i kept insulting him and hating on him, but that was never the case. I went at it with utmost respect for mike, being able to keep an outfit of that size organized as it was(even if it just ran down empty lanes and all, but that wasn't really a concern to me back then. So, HRGC was created. It was originally made by me in addition with two others, a dude who sadly got a wrist injury pretty much after creation and was gone for a long

time, but came back recently, and a dude called havaii.

For me the goal was, grow the outfit, play outfit wars and do better than bho.

I was leading basically every day(have to add, i didn't work at the time so i spent at least 50 hours a week in planetside)

So i believe i went to the most rapidly and most active outfit on miller for a month. We even pushed BHO off the top of the outfit browser back then.

I was able to recruit around 450 members in 2 months, and then it started to stagnate, as I started focusing on Outfitwars.

I believe it will be better to add the outfit wars stuff into the third outfit wars chapter, but i'll put it here short:

I spent even more time on the game, trying to figure out the best way to play the map, rewatching countless streams, rewatching our opponents streams and so on. I went into full on lockdown, figuring out strats, figuring out how to play the map, figuring out how to get us into a position to win the games.

To end this, i'll put a basic description of our OW games in here:

First Match: HRGC vs DIG vs CTIA

We can't really say what happened, but I believe we were severely underestimated, and were able to play in a way where we forced Dig and CTIA to focus on each other and were just able to sit on bases till we had max points before they could realize it.

Second Match: HRGC vs Ares (third outfit didn't show up)

We had the advantage from the start, as we had more members and due to that more bases. Same time, I have to give a shoutout to ares, as they put up a fight even with less numbers. Huge respect to you guys!

Third Match: HRGC vs Ruin vs KOTV

This match was our first real test. I know that people say we double teamed Ruin, but that is the cost of being considered a stackfit.

The plan from our side was to focus on ruin as much as we could, as we saw ruin as the bigger threat and we did so. Luckily for us, KOTV apparently thought the same, and we kinda just rolled with it and won this match by 150 points.

Fourth Match: HRGC vs Ruin vs KOTV

Same match, but different outcome:

Let's be honest. We didn't expect ruin to come blasting out right from the start as they did. Ruin was a powerhouse of an outfit, and they steamrolled both us and kotv at the same time.

It was the closest match we had, with us winning by just 32 points difference in the end. The end score of this match was:718 Ruin, 712 KOTV and us on 750. We can't say really what made us think ruin was a stackfit, but lots of rumors were going around and so I just jumped on the hate stackfit meta and yeah. That's that.

(i'm not sure what our 5th match was) But i believe it was BRTD vs HRGC vs VCBC

Our 5th match wasn't really considered an actual match for us, as we just gave everyone who isn't in our roster beforehand the opportunity to jump in for the rewards. So we came with 4 squads of people who didn't have a clue what to do, and we just vibed till the end.

OW 3 Season Finale: BRTD vs VCBC vs HRGC

Not much to say about this one. I made mistakes, and hugely underestimated BRTD BRTD basicly farmed us for the entire match, which I believe to be credited to their insane pilots.

BRTD won it, and that is it.

Final word: HRGC will always stay a platform for everyone to enjoy playing, in a chaos or tactical way.

We dont care who you are, you can be trans, lesbian, gay, or whatever really. As Long as you show your comrades respect, they will show you respect.

To give my final thoughts on OW3. We went in with the mindset to beat bho. Nothing else.

I know some of our members got a little overly excited, but give us that.

Noone expected an outfit coming from an ex bho dude to roll straight into finals, and we achieved that with a little bit of luck, huge amounts of work and a roster that followed me without any question or complaints. I am truly grateful for all the friends and people I got to know thanks to this amazing game and all the people that followed me into an unknown journey in which we surprised ourselves with how much we succeeded.

After that, I suffered and still am suffering from burnout from the game, especially due to all the drama with mike33.

I then gave away the lead of HRGC to DanishScorpio, who since then is the active leader in HRGC.

Since then, we kept growing, we kept playing, but nothing I'd consider important has happened since then.

HRGC CHAPTER 1.5(Depression)
Continued by UmmHi

First of all I will sadly admit that my actions caused a butterfly effect to the outfit that created most of the drama. Before the outfit wars I invited Asian to HRGC. I believed that he would be able to make his tactical ops with freedom here and happily. That was during the outfit wars. At first I just told him about the BHO drama with HRGC.

He actually didn't play planetside back then. I will admit that I am a reason that he returned.

HRGC was a very successful outfit. It almost won outfit wars. It was the No1 NC outfit in the outfit wars. For a short period it even overtook BHO's NO1 recruiting position in the outfit browser list. Mike didn't like that at all. Being betrayed once again he started putting HRGC=KICK in descriptions till today. That one might have happened before the outfit wars but timeline in this event doesn't matter. It is still HRGC= KICK till this day. After the wars we had our depression phase. Less and less people felt like leading. The outfit was slowly dying. We had some drama in the meantime. The first one besides BHO, was after the outfit wars during our screenshots. Valkyrie CodeWolfy wanted to take pictures for the clan but someone didn't like them and she got offended and just left the scene. She said she was a professional photographer. The other guy didn't deem them that professional and then it started. Thunderstorm learnt about this soon since everyone was there and he said how we want respect towards everyone and stuff like that. If I am not mistaken the guy got a warning for his behavior. He didn't actually mistreated anyone, he just said his opinion. Opinions still can hurt feelings. After that some people were careful with her around.

As I mentioned less people were interested in leading and activity was slow. Thunderstorm went from leading 25/7 to barely once a week and later he moved on to overwatch officially. Asian had created his tactical division within HRGC. He volunteered to lead more so he requested a promotion which he got a few days later. He didn't like how nobody felt like leading and he was rightfully complaining about the leadership activity. He joined an outfit to see that nobody wants to keep it alive by leading. Some of us. Understood that and started stepping up for leading. We didn't want our outfit to die and give BHO the laughs. We had the division up and running but the first issue that we encountered was people's complaints. Asian is the type to joke around with insults and some people not knowing Asian took some of his words too seriously and people were disatisfied with the outfit. I believe some even left. That caused trouble but that didn't stop the division from existing. Nobody was forced to participate in the tactical division, but people considered it part of the outfit, so they had the same expectations of casual. One day Asian jokingly told sandryn the female member of the council to go back to the kitchen and Asian not knowing when to stop he kept repeating that. From that point people really started disliking Asian. I remember talking to Asian about the situation and he didn't expect them to actually hate him for his actions due to nobody telling him to stop doing that or telling him that they seriously didn't like. They preferred to gossip about it in the background instead. Thunderstorm as said before was gone. He was playing on his hiatus from planetside2. He would only return when something serious happened like drama like that. After that period we go to coolboy part. Coolboy was a guy minding his own business. He would join the voice chats on discord. At some point PLs/SLs noticed that sometimes he would ignore orders. He wouldn't response as if he was muted. At times he would be with us but probably because the farm was beneficial to him. The guy signed up for tactical. To join tactical he had to read 2-3 paragraphs for the introduction to tactical and the expectations he should have had. He ignored them because he deemed them too long to read. He would join anyway the tactical squads because we had them public for recruitment. He kept minding his own business not following orders so he kept getting kicked.

One morning I was chilling with coolboy and a newer guy. The new one was asking for tips and I remember having a debate on helpful advice. Coolboy would suggest the guy upgrade cortium capacity alongside cortium detection range. Imn my opinion detection range is more important than capacity. At rank 1 of cortium capacity which is cheap you get 1k extra cortium storage. After that it goes between 1-2k until the last upgrade. Even without upgrading capacity at a not maxed level, the amount of cortium piles mined stay the same. Leaving cortium with a tiny portion is a bick move in my opinion. Back in those days the small pile contained 2k cortium instead of 4. Oh something to add. The newer guy was into construction so that's why we didn't go suggesting repair nades,rez nades etc. Coolboy also suggested to the new guy to buy exp boosters with merit from sanctuary but that would slow down his access to the tactical deployables. That is kind of irrelevant to the whole Miller history but it is an experience I had so why not mention it? Historians would kill to learn a random family conversation from the past.

We are going back to our chronicles of this book. Coolboy now officially hated Asian now and his tactical division. The breaking point was when Asian had given an order to jump off an air pad towards a double stack building somewhere on Esamir. I don't remember where it is. If I am not mistaken it is Elli tower. Some people died from fall damage. Normally you shouldn't die from there but they probably got shot by something that contributed to assisted deaths. Coolboy lost faith in tactical and so here we are. Don't expect Asian to be a god tier SL/PL. He plays strategy games but him being an inactive planetside player let alone leader he gets rusty during his planetside breaks but he does have the required brain cells to read the situation, map in general. He only lacks the practical experience of planetside like for example expecting BHO to drop at the crown when they regroup at the warpgate. Even a real life commander would lead worse in planetside having no experience. At some point coolboy wanted to use outfit orbital strikes but he couldn't. In order to use outfit resources you needed to be a dedicated leader which he was not. He convinced someone to give him permission to use the OS by promoting him. He used the orbi that way but there was an idsue. During that time we had a casual platoon or tactical squad and we needed to use the orbital strike. It was in an alert time too. We reminded ourselves that we had one after seeing that we had one. Eventually the orbital strike was needed but by then it was used by coolboy. It should be noted that his orbital strike use wasnpurely for farm and not strategical assistance. Asian demoted him from squad leader since he never squad lead in the first place. Coolboy went to complain to Thunderstorm. After that we had a council

on what to do with coolboy. Quite few gad issues with coolboy which was another reason for the meeting. The meeting lead nowhere after an hour without exaggerating. One of the council members got sick of the situation and left the outfit because he was sick of us having an hour long meeting with no decisions on the matter. After that Asian kicked coolboy out of the outfit on the spot. We couldn't lose a valuable council member who contributed to the outfit for a while for the sake of someone who was focusing on himself.

I do not recall the rest of the talk but later we decided to keep coolboy out of HRGC 100% because he threatened HRGC with DDOS. The last thing you want to do to remain in an outfit is to spread threats.

After that we didn't have any major events besides people moving on. Asian had given up on tactical and moved on with other games. So how we went there. Asian was talking to Thunderstorm because he suddenly returned from overwatch in the HRGC chill chat. Thunderstorm's broken promises to lead didn't give us good impressions so we were worried about the outfit. Ever since post outfit wars he promised that he would lead but every time he had an excuse to not make it at the last moment. It was revealed later that it was real life stuff and overwatch after he admitted it himself. Some including Asian were skeptical if he even had the chores he had, not because he didn't lead but because every time he would cancel ps2 plans at a last moment notice. Asian did tell him to make plans a week ahead but make sure he ended up fulfilling his promise to lead whenever he announced it. Still same stuff. Others were also pointing out the inactivity of HRGC. In the discussion we had with the people at that time on the discord voice room Asian recommended Thunderstorm that he steps down from leader and so he did later on. He gave outfit lead to Danish. Most of the casual platoon leaders were in tactical division so we needed someone to focus on casual platoons. And that's how Skodush became the head of casual division(back then, things have changed a little bit since then). I believe there was a final drama discussion with Asian and council and Asian left yet another outfit like a chord he is. I don't remember much after that. Council members started leaving HRGC for other NC outfits. Unlike BHO it didn't mean they couldn't play together. They still chilled on discord as they always did and that is one of the big positives of HRGC discord. Not that other outfits ban it. Beside nation exclusive outfits and BHO I don't think anyone else keeps strangers away. Those other outfits don't hate if

you belong elsewhere but they have language barriers so it is understandable.

Lately HRGC has been blowing up again and I am really happy to see that. Even Thunderstorm is very active again. They even have a tactical division that Asian tried to reopen with Danish's permission. It didn't go well once again with the relationship so Asian left once again. They kept the division though.

Personally, after the seperation, I moved to VS in KITV aka KOTV. I will have a seperate chapter for KOTV. I have missed a lot of history so I can not go further than a few months behind.

The 300s split and creation of HMGD, leading to the creation of the Church Of TI Alloys

One of the core members of 300s was a good British man known as BoltTrooper, he led quite frequently and noticed the tendency of Brubaker to only focus VS which he deemed bad for an outfit as big as that. After some time he decided to leave 300s a make a new outfit with those who would follow him. These few people made The Terran Homeguard (HMGD), the first few members Llydia, BoltTrooper, Nayllo and Hostis played on their own for a few days, eventually recruiting some new members to the point we'd get our first squads. It's at that point BoucheDagTR and some Scottish man joined us, the name's neeber and I never ever could understand what he said but the two eventually became leading figures in HMGD.

At the same time the outfit 10KP (10.000 Persians) grew a lot, led by the former VoGu player GamblingSabre (known today as BilliBobBillsen). HMGD and 10KP thought about merging as they were both relatively small outfits compared to 300s in terms of activity, that way they would be more competitive on the TR side and maybe get enough influence to get brubaker to eventually stop focusing VS. They made BwB "Better Without Brubaker" community to merge the two outfits into a single big platoon. After receiving complaints and toxicity from Brubaker himself for the name they used, they decided to change the name so long as Brubaker ceased harassment towards their members, though he broke this agreement multiple times and they changed back to BwB several times. They merge under a single name decided through a meeting. The proposition that was kept was CTIA "The Church Of TI Alloys", the outfit kept on going since then and many of the earliest members are still doing good. Be wary though because some people say that, at night, when there is no fighting, you can hear faint screams of brubaker echoing through the powerhouse of TI Alloys.

The disbanding

One day BruBaker said in command chat that if they lost the alert,he would disband the 300s. TR players hearing that rushed to NC or VS to help TR lose the alert. The alert was actually lost for the TR. BruBAker disbanded the 300s. The next day they were gone. I (UmmHi)was there when it happened on the NC side with BHO. I was witnessing this live with Mike and the rest. I don't know how Mike got the news since

it was him who informed us about the news of his plans to disband if they lost. Surprisingly it was real. And here the first part of the chapter ends here with BruBaker going for a long break from planetside2. During Mike's absence he infiltrated BHO to double team VS. He was actually leading BHO to double team. For the rest of the details check the updated Asian chapter. Brubaker had disappear ed from Miller but not the game. After that he moved to cobalt. I have no clue what happened in there but after talking to a few cobalt players they didn't like it when Brubaker was there.

Brubaker's return

In 2021 Brubaker returned. Just as he disappeared like the avatar he returned just like the avatar out of nowhere. As you probably know from the 300s story and Bru's past, he is a very toxic person who yells a lot. This time it was different. In his return we got the great depression era of his. We don't actually know if it was depression but the returned Brubaker is not the one we knew. He was calm and chill. He still wanted to win alerts and give orders to win but when something went wrong, he wouldn't yell(always). Since I was on the NC side in his prime time, I couldn't actually see what the deal was about him besides the videos on YouTube. When he returned I checked his platoons. As I said he was chill. He did scream in his first moments but then he stopped. Ever since then he has been very quiet. Of course I can't join every single squad he makes so this is just speculation from my side. Others have noticed the same thing so I am not the only one. He created the 2021 outfit. The year of his return. He made it on TR. Later on he moved to VS. If I am not mistaken people kinda bullied him so he was joining outfit ops of other outfit s to find a home. He might still be looking for a new home even though he has his own outfit. At some point a few months ago he even used text to speech to avoid detection and making alt characters. Currently he is back to TR but it is too early to further conclude his home. I have heard rumors that he is slowly reverting back to his old self but only time will tell.

Outfit Wars Season 1 and Drama

Outfit wars is usually a yearly event that takes place in an exclusive continent made strictly for those wars. They took place in the map named desolation as usual. In order to participate in them your outfit needed to be inside the Top 3 of the leaderboard. Score was counted based on xp farmed.by ny means. There were 3 tiers. Gold, Silver, Bronze. Top1 was gold tier 2nd Silver and so on. The major outfits were more than 3 per faction so the bigger ones aka the zerging outfits had a big advantage. Engineer and medic population skyrocketed. Some clans like Wuhan would have shifts on ghost capers. Ghost caping zergs of the day, ghost capers of the night. 24h zerging not even kidding I remember that myself. Many outfits hated them for that. Now from here on there is a requirement of BHO history knowledge. The center of attention of the wars was BHO. I will change the following info later due to being out of topic but the part isn't yet covered in the book so here is a summary. BHO had drama with leaders leaving right before outfit wars, it went in panic mode for new leaders, they found them and went inside with 0 practical training because lane zerging and recruiting new players was a higher priority than training for the wars. In the gold tier we had BHO VS WUHAN VS K outfit. BHO led by Mike. K lead by Himvince(ex BHO 2nd in command leader) and Wuhan lead by fill here guys.

So how it worked. There were some neutral bases. Before the beginning outfits eligible for the fight could warp to the continent 30m before the start of the match. There were 0 spawn options. It was just like oshur where you have to bring the logistics yourself. The bases were all the same in a donut shape. I will drop a video link anyway to watch the match so further explanation would be redundant. Finding the match is hard. If I find it I will post.

There is a ring arena in Oshur very similar to that. The fight was surprising. BHO with their leading incompetence were supposed to lose but won. Apparently they paid Himvince 200 euros to double team the Wuhan outfit in response to their 24h zergs. BHO won and then we had this masterpiece of reactions. For this paragraph you will need to read UmmHi's BHO story perspective.

The most anticipated match on the entire Miller server and its entire history.

BHO beat HRGC as you saw from the twitch vod. There is a problem though, BHO has been exposed for paying money to win as theorized in the first ever outfit wars. There is a difference now though. This time Mike stacked about 1 squad of planetside sweatlords to aid him in his fight with HRGC. Mike promised free 40\$ bundles to them as a reward. Some of the ringers themselves posted the bundles they got gifted in the Miller discord chat "#ps2_casual".

HRGC didn't like their defeat but they did not and still do not accept their defeat. From their side, BHO had to hire pro planetside players to beat them, refusing their loss towards "BHO". On the other hand, HRGC got backlash for their complaints because they still lost. Their logic is that: Since you are confident that you can beat BHO with ease why did it only take about 1 squad to turn the tables?

After this drama talk began on the miller chat with thunderstorm trying to get Mike banned for doing this. People mocked Thunderstorm because they knew how pointless it was. I haven't made a chapter about it yet but Thunderstorm is trying to ban Mike for his toxicity towards the server with lawyers included but he has been doing it for a long time since then so the progress is doubtful despite his claims against it. Only time will tell.



KOTV fought with BHO and KOTV won. Mike had bought ringers just like in the HRGC match but this time they couldn't bring the 48 people in the game. We don't know the reason yet but it is speculated that BHO people abandoned Mike because he had to put actual BHO people on the bench for the sake of some more skilled players fighting for BHO. After BHO's defeat, some BHO platoon leaders left BHO to check out KOTV. They explained how it was inside BHO. It is uncertain that they will specifically join KOTV but for sure they are not going back to BHO therefore BHO losing platoon leaders once again since drama happens approximately every year with their drama history written above.

The platoon leaders not only left BHO but now they have exposed proof of BHO cheating their way to attempted victory. Here is a video of classified BHO information recorded by the betrayed BHO members.

ARSHEE TV

ArsheeTV is a twitch streamer who loved to stream community related events on planetside2. He didn't focus on specific servers. He visited all of them. He wanted to check all the communities in the game. He started around 2020. Most of the times, he would stream outfit spotlights and OW matches.

He was hyperactive in his streams but people still liked them. He would always have 50+ viewers on an average stream and on big events he would reach hundreds. He slowly became more and more popular. He would host events with outfits like bastion events and races. Funnily enough, he barely actually played the game. Most of the time he would be on his observer camera.

Afterwards he became more popular and he was technically verified by the developers. His videos would be featured in the launcher screen. Because of outfit wars other content creators also raised their recognition. It was the content creator era. Something that was exciting was the fact that there was no drama between them. Drama at some point existed due to a questionable action with obs camera. But that was between community and a certain creator, not between the creators themselves. Most games have content creator drama. In planetside 2 that was not the case.

ArsheeTV was unique. No streamer made the community the selling point of their channel and that was ArsheeTV. Yes of course they care about the community and talk about community/game news but it wasn't the only kind of content. A year later ArsheeTV lost his prime. People knew about his kind of content and eventually it ran out. Outfits advertised themselves on twitch with Arshee but they weren't and never be infinite. Arshee had covered everything, his view count dropped. He was in need of growing his channel. Planetside couldn't keep his channel alive. He still likes the community but the ideas have been depleted.

ArsheeTV had moved on. He no longer streams planetside 2 but there is a chance, he might make a return with the upcoming outfit wars. Now readers the following covers ArsheeTV's decision to move on. For Miller historic content watch the videos of his interactions with our server and leave it there.

ArsheeTV became an IRL streamer. He would go places with friends and see stuff around US states. At that point Arshee having created a community from planetside2 some of the ps2 community members still stick around Arshee which is a nice thing to see. Origins should never be forgotten. After some time he made gym content and then sailed to a New World. It is an MMO and popular. Bigger community, more content for him. Till this day ArsheeTV streams New World with his community. He has a stable community and let's hope he succeeds in getting verified on Twitch and becomes popular. He is a nice guy and engaged with his community.

CHEATER HUNTING CHAPTER

It all started at 26/12/2023. I was streaming planetside 2 like any other. A flying max appeared and started killing everyone. I was playing TR and I remember seeing clips of people ramming him with ESFs. I thought it would be fun for the stream to try it. Killing a cheater feels like completing a raid boss afterall. I won't go in detail with words because I actually have a video of it. I will find it and post it here. One thing that wasn't included in the video, after the first kill, on another attempt he chased me all the way to my warpgate. He got my scythe(I switched faction to make the hunt easier) but I jumped out right outside my warpgate and survived. That was still a victory on my end. I distracted the cheater away from the main fights AND he didn't kill me.

Aftwr that, I wanted to dedicate myself to protecting the planet. Back then we didn't have underground turrets. It was flying maxes all the time. I am partially responsible for the cheats evolving. After some time. My friend Freebeer joined kotv, he loved doing exploits and sharing, he was naughty at first and he got kicked. He would place routers underground and kill people. He got banned twice. After the second one, he stopped because his next is perma. Freebeer is an old friend from back in BHO days. Never talked much back then. Anyway, he would show me how to exploit. He taught me how to go underneath the ascetunnbehind nason's tunnels which by the way still work to this day. I even sent the devs the tutorials on recreating them and they still haven't fixed them. They did fix fishing and vehicle exit exploit so I will be a optimistic for a bit more. Knowing that, I knew I could take down the cheater in those areas. Those are the hottest ones too so usually they would go there. After a long time, cheaters actually start coming. Unfortunately they started going underneath the map. I couldn't do anything, or could I? Before Freebeer got kicked, I saw people using ESFs to get underneath the map. Those people would do it to ruin the fun by farming with A2G from under the map. What if I did that to cheaters. So I sat with freebeer 1 day. We discussed how we could possibly do it, he didn't know. I figured out the way and it started. The birth of the anti cheat hero.


At first, it was easy, underground turrets in open areas. Cheater would deploy a turret on top of crown tunnels and I would kill him. He would come back, rinse and repeat. Cheater's ego was getting damaged. "I can't die to a filthy mortal when I am using hacks. I will come on top and put him in his place" probably what he was thinking. This is where the arms race had begun. After a few minutes he started going inside rocks, I found a way to get inside those rocks from underneath. He would then go to other rocks I couldn't enter, this is where I lost my battle. This was the first time the cheater started going inside ammo towers. After that, I

had to find a way to kill him inside rocks and ammo towers. I had an idea. When landing too fast on a lib or valk, the gunner can see through the ceiling for a split second. What is the equivalent of doing this from underneath the map? Doing this from below, but all gunners are on the bottom. How do I get a gunner on top? That's right, the dervish. This is where I needed help from people, I can't kill him alone since the dervish will descent by itself after leaving the pilot seat. I created the exploit police of auraxis. I would find people too angry towards the cheater. That way I know they really are pissed at him and want to fight him. I found some and invited them at my dervish using logistics specialist implant. After some thinking, I decided to find people on Emerald. I needed help. I found some help but sadly it was mostly help for the moment. My methods are against tos afterall. I needed help to fight the cheaters at all times since I can't take care of Emerald time zone as a european. I found a few with obs cams. I also did something controversial but it hasn't gone wrong for a long time so I believe I found the right people. I taught my methods to a selected few. None of them till this day have abused this power so that means I found the right people to entrust this power. I hadn't reported the exploit until later on my ban phase which we will get into very soon. I will say this though, they fixed it ever since oshur came out. They just never bothered to fix it for the other maps. With things so far, I can take care of any underground mana turrets with some exception spots. Cheaters aren't dumb enough to not find a way to 1 up me once again, they started going inside flying sundies. With flying sundies, I had to find a way to 1 shot them especially with the sundy rework update making them tankier. Thankfully I did. One day, while I was playing, I was looking at my scythe once and thought, what if I place tank mines on top of my scythe? I tried it and it worked! My mines were slipping but I got The gist of it really quickly. That was when airstriking on planetside2 was born. I wasn't even thinking of the cheater at that time. One Day I was at work and I see on Miller chat complaints of an underground player at the crown. No he didn't use my technique. He wasn't a hacker. I thought he was at first. I came home from work and he was still there. He wassitting under The crown for like 4h straight. I went with my scythe, got him, gone, or so I thought. I could tell he wasn't a hacker because the hacker would return in seconds. He returned out of nowhere at a similar spot. I was looking around for ESFs to take him down but none came. Then I hear him shooting again. I was like "bruh, I just killed you and as a non hacker you return to the same spot? I kill him again and he went offline. 4h of griefing could be saved in a few minutes. Thankfully I got him before prime time. Killing him made me feel empty. It was so easy that it made me feel weird. I am used to hackers with teleportation flying sundies magic bullet and my opponent is this. Good for everyone. Moving on to the next. But how did he do it? I didn't know until later on when I found an underground beacon. The guy would repeat his exploit. He wasn't using an ESF. He was using a valk. I'm saying this only because the devs fixed it in the update before the assault facility update. He wasn't killing from underground. He only had an



Beacon. I had to know how he did it. I played nice to get on his good side to tell me. I promised not to report him. Who's to talk right? :p

Anyway with this and that, I destroyed his beacons, cut a deal for him to stop and not report him. If the others did, not my concern. So how it worked. You would exit a valk at 90 degrees. That would make you exit underneath the map. Now they fixed it trust me I tried for hours. The reason they fixed it was because people accidentally found the ascent sundy exploit. Same concept. Exit the sundy while it is hugging that wall. It was inevitable to be discovered. That doesn't help me kill cheaters inside rocks but anyway. Let's go to my ban era. At this point I have become popular. My cheater hunting videos were already uploaded, the cheater was using my name because he got his ass kicked by me a lot of times. Now it is a random wednesday night. No cheaters. I was playing my LA normally. I randomly get banned at around 8pm my time(GMT+2)/(UTC+2) I wasn't underneath the map. I got kicked by an admin. The cheater was using my name to kill everyone the same day but I wasn't exploiting or anything. I guess the gms mixed up the fake one with the real one. At first I was shadow banned. I could log in but the play button wouldn't work. I created new alt accounts and they worked fine which means, I was banned for real. I yelled for the gm to explain himself but no point. I never received an email for getting banned. All players normally get a 3/7/perma ban on the third strike. I never had a 3day strike. I guess I got 3 strikes in the span of 1 day. I kept hunting the cheater because after that the cheater would log back in and do his thing while I was banned. Unfortunately the exploit police members wouldn't always help. I was pretty much alone again. Nobody left to hunt the cheater. I announced my shadow ban on the exploit police and made a reddit post and video. Thankfully the community supported me and got the devs to unban me. I wouldn't be here without you <3 Thank you everyone. I was ip and hardware banned. When that happens you aren't even allowed to log in on any dbg website. You can make accounts but when you try to log in you get an error. I forgot to mention fishing. After a week of getting hardware and ip banned I discovered a method to glitch through any obstacle. Hacker inside rocks? no problem. bzzzt, I'm in the rock. Here is my biggest regret though it was the right thing. I reported the issue. My perma ban was on the x4 exp event for sundy rework compensation. That update was planned to have fishing inside but it never got it till this day. On day 1 of fishing update on

pts. I discovered I was to glitch through any wall in the entire game. I basically had snail pace no clip. fishing rod had collision which is the main source of every single exploit. I could get inside the scu room before even flipping the A point or get inside a command center spawn room. Or hide inside a wall. Any object you can think of the answer is yes, I could get inside that. I knew this was the perfect opportunity to hunt the cheater but people could eventually figure it out. The outcome of people discovering this would be catastrophic. A hacker kills the fun in one hex at a time. A known exploit that gives you borderline no clip can be abused on all fronts at the same time across all servers. So I decided to report it. It took them 2 months to fix it. Fishing hasn't come out yet but it is fixed, you don't have collision anymore with fishing scanner. The devs have actually fixed some serious exploits. Not all of them but they fixed more exploits than wrel to be fair. But wrel was passionate too. The TR triage pulse however it is called, would block revives on friendlies. It was 1 day before launch at midnight and wrel saw my reddit post and said they would fix it. The next day the patch comes as scheduled but also fixed my bug in less than 24h. Toadman is still new. They even fixed the walls in the new assault focility. I know a secret fishing 2.0 method but it isn't as strong as the original, it has many required conditions to pull it off. I went inside, underneath, everything in the assault facility and I could shoot people through walls on pts. After some feedback updates, they fixed the walls. My theory is that the ground is a 1 way shield. Shooting from underneath lets bullets penetrate but not the other way around. assault facility walls are 2 way now if my theory is true. I don't know why toadman is silent, if everyone knew what kind of exploits they have fixed thanks to me people wouldn't shit on them as much. Now, even if someone glitches through the AF, he won't be able to do anything to anyone. The hacker uses a different way to kill everyone so don't get your hopes up on the hacker being patched yet.

Anyway, enough sidetracking. There isn't much to the story now because I am back on a last warning and I can't go underneath the map anymore. Even the hackers have told me that they have actual gms. They take forever to type that/kick /ban or whatever but they are there. People say it is hacker lies and bs. I believe them. I got to see the ban first hand, and why would cheaters use different names if they wanted to ruin the fun? they just get banned and return. Toadman is just too silent but also slow. I didn't want to give up on cheater hunting so I still do my best to help in any way I can. After seeing a few exploiters after my ban, I discovered that c4s penetrate the ground or any map terrain. Any 1 way shields let's call it which are all the exploit areas. If you c4 a wall in a normal building the guys behind it won't get damaged but when you do it on exploit walls it works. So even if the cheater goes inside an ammo tower, I can still kill him and I don't even need to exploit! Very recently I discovered a new way to hunt the cheaters. It doesn't involve out of bounds but let's just say that this is my new power against the cheaters and if you get it you get it.

I'm not joking it is very similar lol. This is where I am now, if I see a cheater I will do my best with my current tools to kill him. The arms race is still not over. Honestly I would love to get a .kick permission, I wouldn't have to do all this to stop the cheater for a few seconds. All I need to do is type /kick cheater and check honu if anyone is having an abnormal kpm and kdr. Anyone can do it. I don't know what gms are doing. They know how the cheats work, people have started advertising them publicly. They don't need any info gathering to ban a cheater. One last word. I have sent the devs all the exploits I know so far. They just haven't

fixed them yet and honestly it should be very simple, especially the esf one which got patched since oshur came out.

THE ROYS
