

Lesson 2.10: Publishing Your Narrative Worksheet - **Note:** Please do not submit your final draft until you have received feedback on your first draft from your instructor.

1. Use the highlighting tool in your word processor to **highlight at least five examples of vivid detail in your narrative.**
2. Use a different color to **highlight at least five interesting verbs** used in your writing.
3. Use a **third color to highlight your use of temporal words or transitions.** These are words such as, *first, second, finally*
Note: If you do not have enough examples to highlight, you should go back to your draft and see if further revisions are needed. A strong narrative will have at least 5 for each.

Paste your highlighted narrative in this space. Provide a key so your instructor can tell which color highlighter you used for each category.

Reflection 1: Name the two people who reviewed your draft and discuss in a minimum of three sentences how their feedback helped you improve your writing.

Reflection 2: Compare your first draft and your final draft side by side. Discuss in at least three sentences the changes you made and why your final draft is an improvement over your first draft.
