

2021-2022 Drop Off and Pick Up We learned lessons from last year, sorted the 178 or so K - 8 families by grades, and consulted with a traffic engineer for this year's plan. 📍 Drop off/Pick up Map 2021-2022

EVERY FAMILY only has ONE drop off/pick up spot.
K - 8 Drop Off is from 8:00 - 8:15, Pick up 3:15 - 3:30

If **ALL** of your students are in 4th - 8th grade you will drop off and pick up heading south on Nevada Street (front of the school). Please stay in the line and pull forward, and continue south on Nevada until 21st South, or East on Redondo Ave.

Beginning at 8:00 AM middle school students (6 - 8) will walk directly into the building and upstairs to their homeroom which should begin at 8:10. Fourth and fifth graders will line up by the flag pole.

If you have any students in K - 3 you will drop off and pick up all your students in the parking lot.

Beginning at 8:00 middle schoolers with younger siblings will be dropped off in the parking lot and walk directly to their homerooms using the door in the faculty parking lot. Class should begin at 8:10.

Fourth and Fifth graders with younger siblings who are dropped off in the parking lot will walk through the doors by the gym, out past the fountain and go through the garden gate to walk along Nevada to their line by the flag pole.

We will have both kindergartens lined up along the library wall. With second grade west of them.

First grade will be lined up next to the kitchen/gym wall with 3rd grade west of them.

We will empty four cars at a time and please turn right when leaving the parking lot.

PICK UP happens in the same location. Middle schoolers who DO NOT have younger siblings will line up on Nevada, in front of the fifth grade classroom.

We will have a microphone in each location to call out family names. A family car sign should be displayed so that it is easily read. On Nevada St., with older students, they may load into a car as they see fit. **HOWEVER**, cars should pull forward in **one line**. Popping out into traffic on Nevada is a dangerous situation. Again, cars should head south or east at the intersection of Redondo and Nevada.

Older siblings who were dropped off in the parking lot, return to the parking lot and wait with one of their younger siblings to be loaded into cars.

If parents are parked, particularly PreK parents they may pick up and walk their students to their car. The crosswalk at the front of the line should be used, or walking along the playground fence to those spots.

Cars should turn right at the exit on 2300 East.

If you are late the student should be dropped off at the front of the school and be checked in at the office before heading to class.
