- 9<sup>th</sup> grade math placement is determined by middle school performance, using multiple measures.
- ^ Freshmen who wish to take World History or AP World History (typically a sophomore-level course) in place of a freshman elective must have a minimum 3.0 academic GPA.
- Unless otherwise specified, students are enrolled in courses for an entire year and schedule changes will only occur if students are misplaced in an academic level, or to balance classes. **Teacher and period requests will not be honored.**
