Dr. Krippene, 31, Stoughton Dentist, Dies in Oshkosh

Dr. Thomas B. Krippene, 31, a dentist at Stoughton and former Oshkosh resident, died Sunday at 12:05 a.m. at Mercy Hospital, following an illness of one week. He was hospitalized Saturday.

He was born in Oshkosh on July 3, 1926, son of Mr. and Mrs. B. J. Krippene, attended public schools here and graduated from Marquette University Dental School in 1952.

Dr. Krippene had been practicing dentistry in Stoughton for the past three years. A veteran of World War II, he served with the medical corps of the Navy. He was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church, secretary-treasurer of Stoughton Rotary Club, member of American Dental Association and Dane County Dental Society.

Surviving are his parents in Oshkosh; one brother, Urban Krippene, Menasha; two sisters, Miss Betty Krippene, Oshkosh, and Mrs. James Kelsh, Columbus; and several nieces and nephews.
