Budget compared with actuals: Accommodations are way higher, though this is mainly due to the delay in bringing accommodations through.

Membership prescriptions are the same as they were before

Food purchases are down compared to last year.

Insurance is increasing in \$\$

Office admin fees are stable.

Repairs and maintenance - higher fee than last year, as we are now paying a builder for what was originally done by volunteers.

Need to be aware that the older people are getting older, the workforce is decreasing in ability.
