COMES NOW the Plaintiff, the State of SimDemocracy (hereinafter “SD,” “The State,” “Prosecution,” or “Government”), by and through its appointed State’s Attorney, Ed, acting under the direction of the Attorney General, and for its Complaint against Defendant barbacue.

I. PARTIES

1. Plaintiff State of SimDemocracy is the Government of the SimDem Discord and Subreddit.
2. Plaintiff Ed is a State’s Attorney, under the direction of the Attorney General, to act as Prosecutor for this case.
3. Defendant: *@keepbloxburgsafe* on Discord aka barbacue, a citizen of SimDemocracy.

II. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. The Court has personal jurisdiction over the Defendant as a citizen of SimDemocracy, and the actions in question occurred within its jurisdiction.
2. Venue is proper pursuant to the Criminal Code of 2020, Article 1, §1, as all alleged criminal acts were committed on the SimDem Discord server.

III. FACTS OF THE SITUATION

On the date in question, the defendant sent a message saying “abolish the qq” and “we don't need these ‘people’ in simdem.” In these statements, “qq” is an abbreviation for the Queer Queens Qlub, a political party openly representing queer individuals. By calling for the abolition of this party, the defendant not only employed demeaning and hateful language but also incited action against a protected group. This direct call to eliminate the Queer Queens Qlub qualifies as first degree hate speech under Article 53a of the criminal code.

IV. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

The State alleges:
