How to clear the cache in Google Chrome

The fastest way to get rid of the cache data in Google Chrome is the option "Clear Browser cache". You can access this function with the following shortcut:

Press the keys [Ctrl], [Shift] and [Del]. Be sure you press all the keys at once.

A new window opens: "Clear Browser cache".

Here you can select in the upper dropdown-menu, for which time period you want to delete the cache data. You can select between "Last hour", "Last 24 hours", "Last 7 days", "Last 4 weeks" or "All time".

If you want to delete all browsing cache, select "All time".

Check the box in front of "Browsing history".

Check the box in front of "Cookies and other site data".

Check the box in front of "Cached images and files".

Submit your selection by clicking the "Delete data" button.

Reload your site.
