

CNA Class

HLTH 1200 - Long-Term Care / Nursing Assistant (C.N.A.)

The course meets the Nebraska Health and Human Services System training requirements for nursing assistant certification and employment in long-term care facilities. The course combines classroom lecture, laboratory application, and clinical experience for development of basic skills needed to care for the elderly. Course content focuses on teaching nursing assistants to provide safe, effective, and caring services to the elderly or chronically ill patients of any age in a long-term care facility.

- Must be at least 16 years of age by time of clinicals
- Completed CNA paper application
- Signed/Dated Technical Standards Validation form
- Signed/Dated Health Professions Policy Acknowledgement form
- Health History/Physical Examination
- Proof of required immunizations
- Proof of current negative (within the past 12 months) TB – Tuberculosis/PPD Skin Test
- DHHS (Background Check)
- One Source (Background Check)

Fees:

Tuition (\$71.00/credit hour) (6.5 credit hours) = \$461.50 (free tuition for Nebraska students while in high school)

Facility fee (\$5.00/credit hour) (6.5 credit hours) = \$32.50 (free tuition for Nebraska students while in high school)
