Parkas: Laundry and Care

The parkas are considered school property and boosters are not responsible for equipment check in or check out, coaches are responsible. Parkas should be laundered at the end of each season.

Parkas are collected and turned in at the team meeting the Monday following sections. The Boosters purchased large bins that are at the middle school. We use these bins to transport and to store the parkas. Boys season begins shortly after girls season, so they should be laundered and returned the week after sections.

The High School will launder the parkas. Laundry service takes 1-2 days. If you contact the <u>athletic department</u> ahead of time you can coordinate a time to drop off and pick-up. It cannot be done after school hours.

Anyone can take the dirty parkas to the High School and place them in the laundry bins. We have had both booster parents and upperclassmen with a large vehicle drop off and picked-up the parkas. It is possible to have the transport taken care of by the school but I don't know that process since it has been easiest to just do it ourselves.
