Pinkerton Academy Track and Field traveled to Merrimack High School on Thursday for the Merrimack Invitational. Here were the highlights:

Senior Captain Jameson Trask earned over a 7 foot PR in Discus, winning in 116' 7"!! She was also 4th in Shot Put with a season best 32' 9.25.

Junior Nicole Blake was fearless against one of the best runners in the state, took it out hard in the 800m, and earned a PR of 2:23.35 in the 800m.

Sophomore Abby Stienecker grabbed a PR in the High Jump, clearing 4' 10" in a tie for 2nd. She also earned 6th in the 300m hurdles (50.66).

Junior Nora Brayall finished 2nd in the 100m dash with a 12.69PR.

Junior Gabby Bedard had a phenomenal debut in the 3200m, finishing 3rd in a blazing 11:41.73.
