# **How to make Music Videos**

### Get gigs

- Gives person an idea that you can be booked by an agent
- Demonstrate a live performance

If you want to make a music department promo video

- Watch a TON of others and note what not to do and what you need to do
- You should be just as aware of your "Music video" influences are just as much as you know what you musical influences are

Get a Wedding videographer because they are available weekdays, its different, and they have good experience

GET A GIMBAL \$120

#### BTS is behind the scenes

B roll doesn't have action but they are shots of environment, artistic shots, no actors, Halls of music department, instruments, etc

• You can use public domain video Pexels.com

Get twice as much material as you think you need, 2-5 with different angles and zooms and framing

Go Pro on edge of violin

Match 4 clicks of audio track with 4 clicks of live audio
Lindsey Sterling went to school for film

Roughly an hour per minute is reasonable

Use your whole bow in the video
