While I have never done anything nearly as ambitious as a 48 state caching trip, I
do know of a cacher in my area with a story to rival that of the group from last
week. I have met wcs24fan once at an event, and we talked about this briefly.
Back in May of 2016, he did a 48 state caching trip in just over eight days. He

slept in his van along the way, traveling about 8300 miles in total. He planned well enough that he only bought one meal for the entire trip. But most impressive to me: *he did this all by himself!*

- But wait, there's more! A little over a year after he completed his trip, he commemorated it by putting out the 48 State Cache Dash series spread around Dane County in Wisconsin. It starts with an intro cache explaining what he did, then the remainder of the caches chronicle his journey for a find in each state. The map placement of the caches simulate a trip around the lower 48 by making a counter-clockwise circuit of the county. Each cache is hidden along the side of the road with a state flag sticker somewhere close to mark the location. I wound up getting FTFs on four of the caches. It's actually through the cache descriptions that I know the specifics of the trip. Most impressive!
