The Rev. Dr. K. G. Sullivan Scholarship

Dr. Sullivan, who was affectionately known as the Padre, served three churches – Canning from 1938–41, Summerside from 1941–51, and the United Church of St. Paul & St. Stephen, Kentville, from 1951–75. During his ministry at Summerside, he was granted leave of absence and served three years as a Chaplain in the Royal Canadian Air Force.

Dr. Sullivan was one of the moving forces in the establishment of the Windsor Elms, the United Church of Canada Home for Senior Citizens, and served as a Director for several years. He, with the assistance of the AOTS Men's Club, helped establish the United Church Camp at Sherbrooke Lake. These facilities enabled him to direct the Big Brother Summer Camp for boys with special needs.

The Padre served the Town of Kentville and surrounding community in many ways. For 23 years he was the active Chaplain of the Kentville Volunteer Fire Department. He was a member of the Rotary Club of Kentville for 20 years and served as its president during 1965-66. He was also a Director of the Kentville Wildcats Baseball Team.

Dr. Sullivan retired from the active ministry of the United Church of Canada on August 31, 1975, when he and Mrs. Sullivan moved to their summer home on the LaHave River in Lunenburg County, Nova Scotia. On May 2, 1982, Padre Ken died.

The Arthur R. Allen Memorial Scholarship

The Arthur R. Allen Memorial Scholarship has been donated in memory of the late Arthur R. Allen for the benefit of deserving students intending to attend university.

Operating Details:

- The one annual Rev. Dr. K. G. Sullivan Memorial Scholarship is **\$1,000** payable to any university or post-secondary educational institution in Canada on behalf of the selected high school graduate.
- The Arthur R. Allen Memorial Scholarship is a scholarship of **\$500** payable to any university on behalf of the selected high school graduate.
- Only high school graduates are eligible in the year of graduation, who attend Central Kings High School, Horton High School, or Northeast Kings Education Centre, and require financial assistance in order to continue their education.
- The student being selected should show consistent academic achievement, humanitarian qualities, and good character with leadership ability.
- The high school graduate selected for the Rev. Dr. K.G. Sullivan Memorial Scholarship may pursue any chosen educational endeavour.

- The high school graduate selected for the Arthur R. Allen Memorial Scholarship is to be intending to pursue a university education.
- All applications, letters of reference and high school transcripts must be received by the Scholarship Committee on or before **Sunday, May 10, 2026** to be eligible. Documentation received after the deadline will not be considered.

The online application form must be completed on or before **Sunday, May 10, 2026**.

2. **High School Transcripts** – The Scholarship Committee requires a PDF copy of your high school transcript. It is to be emailed by the school to the Scholarship Committee on or before **May 10, 2026**:

Applications without a high school transcript will not be considered.

3. **References** – Two letters of reference should be provided from:

- A school staff member; and/or
- Someone with knowledge of your qualifications and character.

Letters of Reference should demonstrate how you meet the scholarship requirements: consistent academic achievement; evidence of humanitarian activities; and good character with leadership ability.
